Students may eat breakfast and lunch free of charge at Dallas Richland College. There are also some options for purchase.



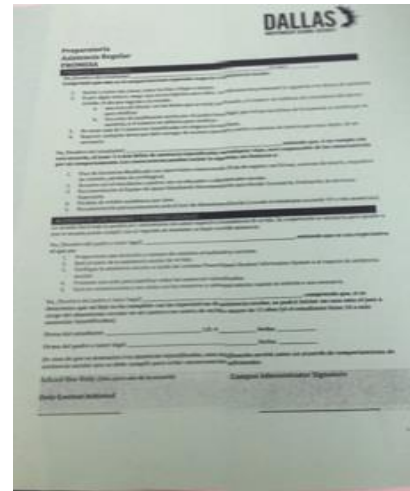

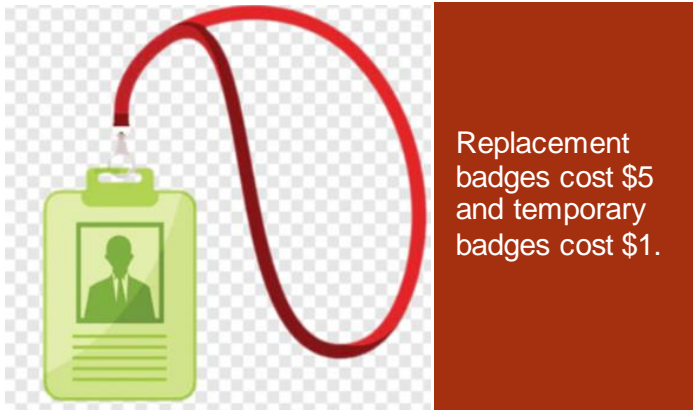
