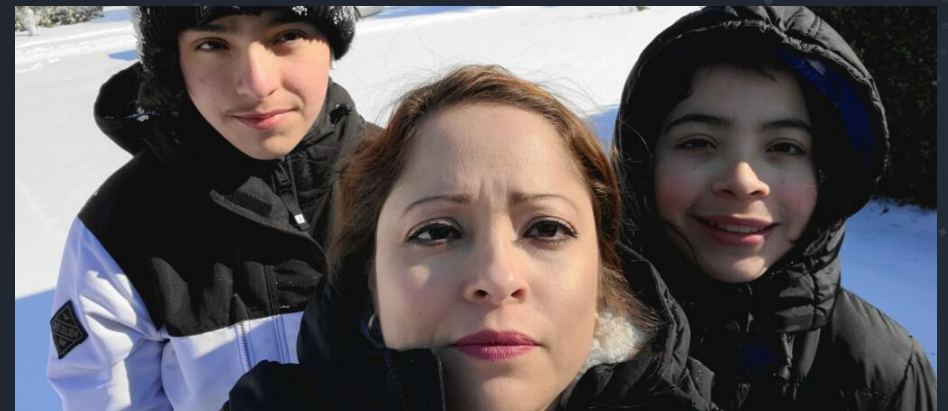


Aquamarine
