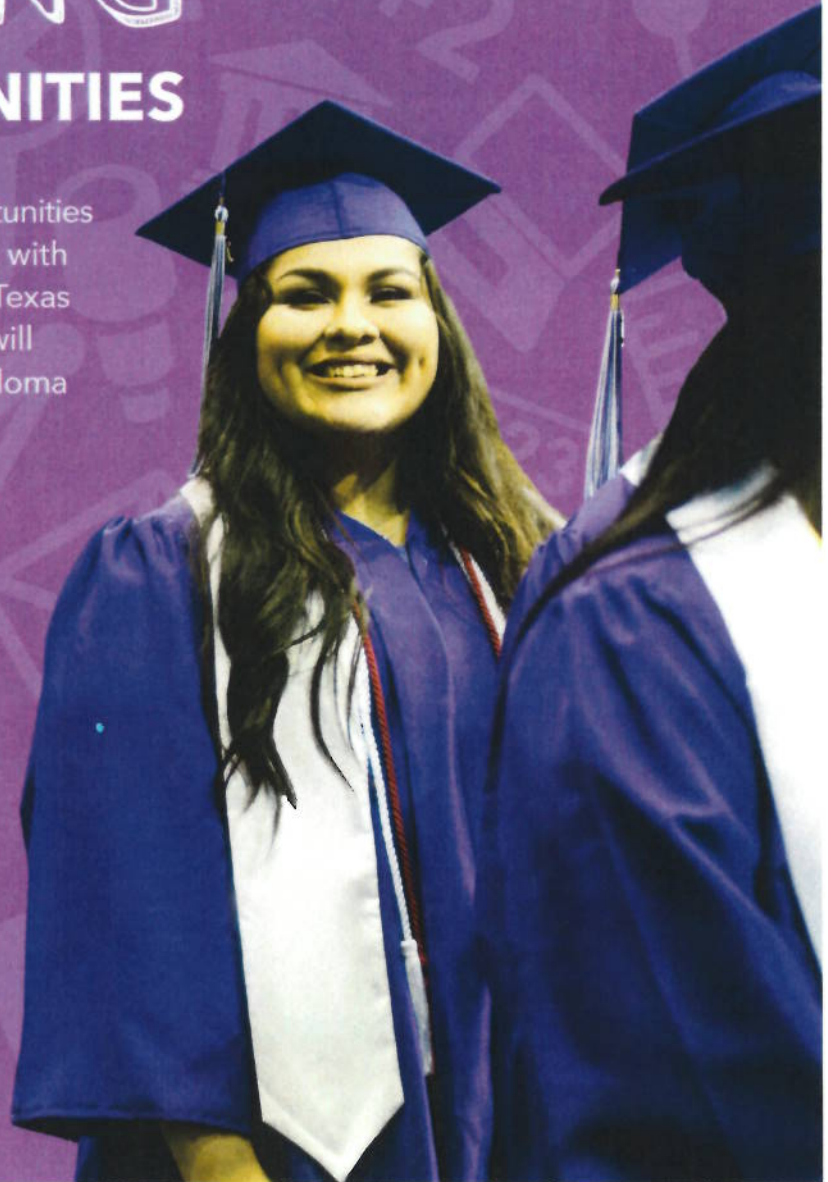


LINCOLN HIGH SCHOOL IS EXPANDING COLLEGE OPPORTUNITIES

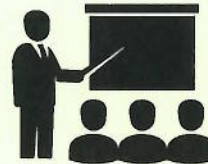

Lincoln B-TECH is designed to serve incoming ninth-grade students who are:

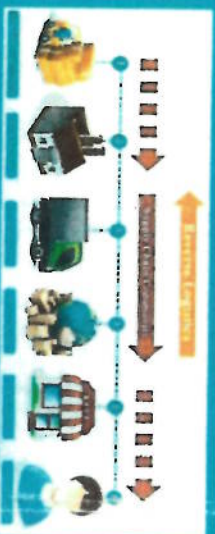
- Determined to attend college.
- First Generation college students.
- Historically underrepresented in higher education.

The academy will accept up to 125 ninth-grade students per year, and students will move together as a cohort as they progress through high school.

Students will attend ninth and tenth grade at Lincoln High School in a dedicated wing of the building. For their junior and senior years, students will attend classes at the University of North Texas Dallas campus. Transportation will be provided at no charge.

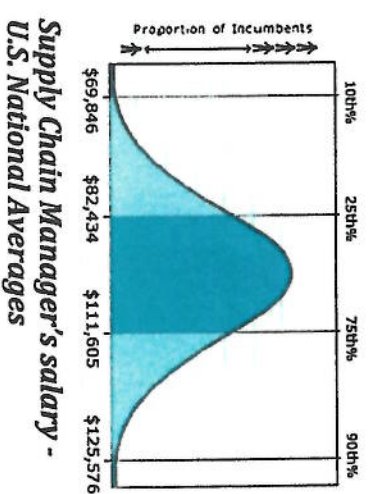
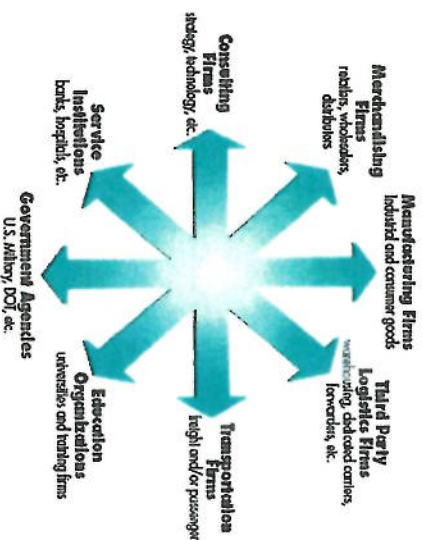

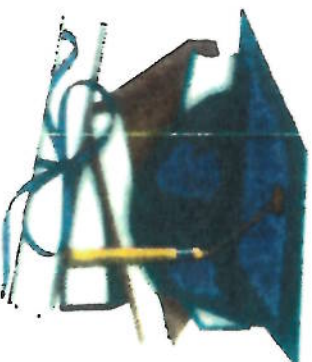

What is an Early College High School?

Lincoln B-Tech Early College High School is a Dallas ISD high school.

Students have the opportunity to earn their high school diploma and receive college credit and/or associate's degrees.

Where will you take classes?

Students will spend their 9th and 10th grade years on the campus of Lincoln High School, being taught by highly qualified teachers and professors from El Centro Community College.

Students will spend the 11th and 12th grade years at El Centro Community College.

Who can attend the ECHS?

Students with:

- ⇒ The desire and determination to attend college.
- ⇒ Strong parental support.
- ⇒ Teacher recommendations.
- ⇒ Great potential but underperforming in a traditional high school setting.
- ⇒ Limited access to higher education.

Why should you attend an ECHS?

The average cost for a two-year degree at a Dallas County Community College is approximately \$6000.

For ECHS students, it's FREE!!!

- ⇒ Tuition fee waived.
- ⇒ College textbooks provided by ECHS.
- ⇒ Transportation provided by Dallas ISD and DART.
- ⇒ Smaller school population

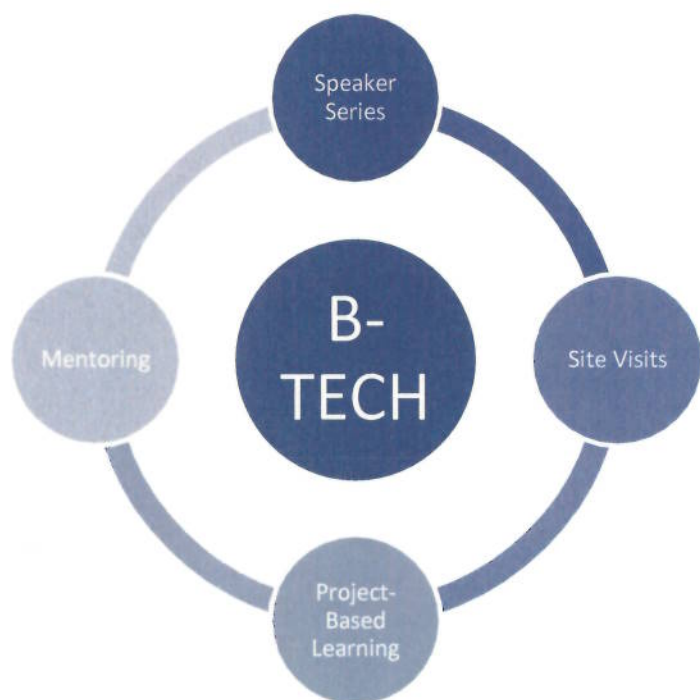

B-TECH is a collaboration between the High School, College and Industry Partners that is designed to provide all students with the education that prepares them for college and careers.
