Lincoln B-TECH is designed to serve incoming ninth-grade students who are:

- Determined to attend college.
- First Generation college students.
- Historically underrepresented in higher education.

The academy will accept up to 125 ninth-grade students per year, and students will move together as a cohort as they progress through high school.

Students will attend ninth and tenth grade at Lincoln High School in a dedicated wing of the building. For their junior and senior years, students will attend classes at the University of North Texas Dallas campus. Transportation will be provided at no charge.
