Dallas ISD Quarter Two will begin on Monday, October 11. We are proud of our students for the hard work and determination that they displayed and know that Quarter 2 will be even better! Students will be receiving their Quarter One report cards on Thursday, October 21, which is the same day as parent-teacher conferences (more information forthcoming).

This week, Coffee with the Principal will take place on Tuesday morning at 8:30am. Campus administration will be available to provide campus updates, answer questions, and collect feedback. On Wednesday, identified DISD scholars and all 10th grade students will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT exam. The PSAT is an exam that serves as a baseline measurement for college readiness. The purpose of the exam is to provide families with feedback and guidance before taking the SAT. More information regarding the PSAT exam can be found below. Finally, as a friendly reminder, next Friday, October 15, is Secondary Fair Day and there will be no school. Students will receive their fair tickets on Thursday, October 14.







PSAT Exam--Wednesday, October 13

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) and PSAT 10 measure what you're learning in school, determine if you're on track, and open doors for opportunities to prepare and pay for college.

Taking the PSAT/NMSQT and the PSAT 10 offers the following benefits to help you prepare for your academic future:

- Be Eligible for the National Merit® Scholarship Program: When you take the PSAT/NMSQT, you may meet requirements to enter the National Merit Scholarship Program and compete for national recognition and college scholarships.
- Learn Your Academic Strengths: After you take the PSAT/NMSQT or PSAT 10, your score report will show how well you performed and which college-level AP courses match your strengths.

COVID-19 Vaccine Incentives for Students (Updated 09/17/2021)

Dallas College Incentive: All North Lake ECHS students are eligible to receive \$200 if they receive the COVID-19 vaccination at one of the Dallas College clinics or show proof of previous vaccination. Starting August 30, students will submit proof of vaccination through an online portal and directions will be shared with all families once they are made available. 
Dallas ISD Incentive: With the safety and well-being of staff and students in mind, Dallas ISD is offering a one-time \$50 vaccination incentive to students ages 12 and older who are fully vaccinated

get the card, parents/guardians or students who are at least 18 should fill out the proof of vaccination form and submit a copy of the student's COVID vaccination card, IMMTrac2 print out or written confirmation from a medical provider by Nov. 15.

How to provide proof of vaccination

- Click on the link to the form https://pznwuubwfdll22r-production.adb.us-phoenix-1.oraclecloudapps.com/ords/r/prod/student-covid-vaccinations
- · Sign in using the student ID number and date of birth
- Fill out the required information
- Upload an image of the proof of vaccination (card, IMMTrac2, document from medical provider)
- · Submit the form





ECHS Uniform Wednesdays!

Students are required to wear their ECHS uniform and either black slacks or a skirt (no shorter than "finger-tip length" with arms in normal position, i.e., arms hanging naturally, as student is standing straight and upright). North Lake ECHS Uniform appointments can be made by contacting Mr. Sergio Godinez at Versa Printing. ECHS uniform days will be seasonal, and a North Lake ECHS polo can be worn through September.

Failure to follow dress code requirements, including ECHS Uniform Wednesdays, will result in Friday Night Lights.

TSIA2 Testing and Preparation

TSI is a state-legislated program designed to improve student success in college. Part of the program is an assessment to determine basic skills in reading, mathematics and writing. A passing score on the TSIA2 test is required in order to take most of the dual-credit courses on our Associate Degree crosswalks. TSIA2 scores also impact our State Accountability rating for College and Career Readiness.

Scoring Standards:

English Language Arts and Reading (ELAR) Standard:

- ELAR Score of 945+ AND Essay Score of 5 8
 OR
- ELAR Score under 945 AND ELAR Diagnostic Level of 4 6 AND Essay Score of 5 8

TSIA2 Math Standard:

- 950+ OR
- Math Score Under 950 AND Math Diagnostic Level of 6

EdReady--TSIA2 test prep website. All students are required to sign-up and create an account. Create an account today using the information provided below:

- 1. Navigate to disd.edready.org and click Get Started.
- 2. After creating their accounts, they will receive an email confirmation with an activation link.
- 3. After logging in they will be prompted to enter a **goal key**. The goal key for all North Lake students is **northlake** (all lowercase). They will be able to access both the math and reading study paths with that one code. And they only need to enter the goal key one time to add it to their dashboard.
- 4. There is a <u>walkthrough video</u> and a <u>student quick start guide</u> at the bottom of the <u>disd.edready.org</u> main page if they need assistance


