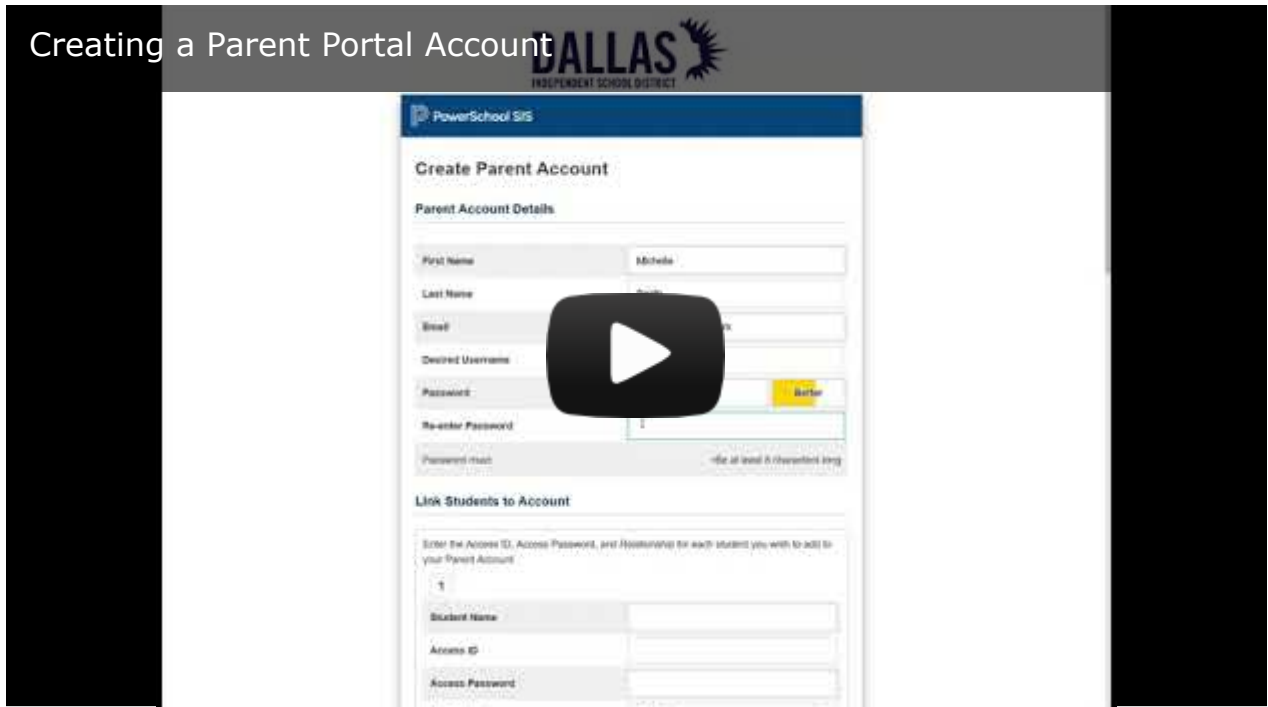

Site-Based Decision Making Committee Get Involved

The **Site-Based Decision Making Committee** serves as an advisory council to the principal. The SBDM committee comprises the campus principal, teachers, school staff, parents, business and community representatives.

The SBDM is designed to be the umbrella for which all school related issues, activities, and initiatives are discussed. The recommendations and suggestions made by the committee should align with the campus improvement plan and promote student achievement. Ultimately, it is the principal who is responsible for the instructional and operational functions of the campus and therefore, final decisions are reserved for the principal.

As school related issues occur or school activities and initiatives evolve, the SBDM committee may authorize a sub-committee to convene to resolve the issue or implement the activity and initiative. Sub-Committees vary from school to school depending on the needs of the campus and community.

North Lake ECHS, Dallas ISD, and Dallas College Return to Mandatory Masking

Effective Tuesday, August 10, to protect staff and students from the spread of the highly contagious Delta variant of the coronavirus, Dallas ISD is temporarily requiring all staff, students and visitors to wear masks when on district property.

The announcement comes as the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Dallas County Health officials have raised the COVID-19 alert to level red and reported that hospitalizations are rising at the fastest rate since the pandemic began, among all age groups, including children. Students under 12 are not eligible for a vaccine, however, school attendance is mandatory, and virtual learning is not an option at this time.

In keeping with the top priority of safeguarding the health and well-being of staff and students, the district will continue to provide masks and sanitizer at district facilities and will continue contact tracing.

Governor Abbott's order does not limit the district's rights as an employer and educational institution to establish reasonable and necessary safety rules for its staff and students. Dallas ISD remains committed to the safety of our students and staff.

Dress Code for the 2021-2022 School Year

Due to COVID-19 and our hybrid learning model, the ECHS uniform day was never enforced. Beginning on the first day of school (August 16, 2021), all students will be expected to adhere to the the North Lake Early College dress code and uniform policy. Wednesday will be "uniform day" On Uniform Wednesdays, **students are required to wear their ECHS uniform and either black slacks or a skirt (no shorter than "finger-tip length" with arms in normal position, i.e., arms hanging naturally, as student is standing straight and upright).** North Lake ECHS Uniform appointments can be made by contacting Mr. Sergio Godinez at Versa Printing.

Students will be required to follow the North Lake Dress Code on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Please see the image below which outlines the do's and don'ts.

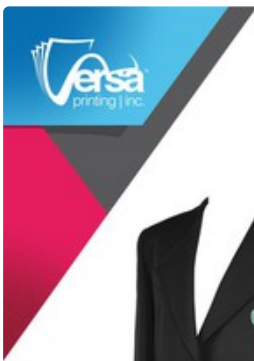

	Guidelines	What not to wear
Shirts, Blouses	Shirts should be school appropriate and cover to the shoulder waistline. Sleeveless shirts should be 2" in width on the shoulder.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spaghetti strap shirts Off the shoulder shirts Crop-tops Backless shirts
Pants, Jeans, Leggings	Full length and capri length pants and jeans are acceptable. Pants must be worn at the natural waistline. Leggings may be worn if they are non-see through and covered by a skirt or shirt that covers to finger-tip length.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tights substituted for leggings/pants Distressed jeans with holes higher than finger-tip length Pajama bottoms
Shorts, Skirts, Dresses	Shorts, skirts and dresses length should be finger-tip length or longer.	
Shoes	Shoes must be worn at all times. Appropriate shoes include athletic tennis shoes, loafers/dress shoes, and closed-toe sandals.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flip-flops Slides House shoes
Hats, Other head coverings	Only head coverings that are religious in nature should be worn in the building.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hats/beanies Bandanas Hoods Visors
School ID Badges	School ID badges must be worn in a visible place at all times. Lanyards must be used.	

No items containing offensive slogans, symbols or other suggestive or controversial designs may be worn.

Students in violation of the student dress code will be expected to change to appropriate attire. Students will not be allowed to leave campus for the purpose of changing clothes.

Students who persistently violate the dress code will be held accountable following the Dallas ISD Student Code of Conduct and be forced to wear assigned campus uniform.

TSI is a state-legislated program designed to improve student success in college. Part of the program is an assessment to determine basic skills in reading, mathematics and writing. **A passing score on the TSIA2 test is required in order to take most of the dual-credit courses on our Associate Degree crosswalks. TSIA2 scores also impact our State Accountability rating for College and Career Readiness.**

Scoring Standards:

English Language Arts and Reading (ELAR) Standard:

- ELAR Score of 945+ AND Essay Score of 5 – 8
OR
- ELAR Score under 945 AND ELAR Diagnostic Level of 4 – 6 AND Essay Score of 5 - 8

TSIA2 Math Standard:

- 950+
OR
- Math Score Under 950 AND Math Diagnostic Level of 6

EdReady--TSIA2 test prep website. All students are required to sign-up and create an account. Create an account today using the information provided below:

1. Navigate to disd.edready.org and click **Get Started**.
2. After creating their accounts, they will receive an email confirmation with an activation link.
3. After logging in they will be prompted to enter a **goal key**. The goal key for all North Lake students is **northlake** (all lowercase). They will be able to access both the math and reading study paths with that one code. And they only need to enter the goal key one time to add it to their dashboard.

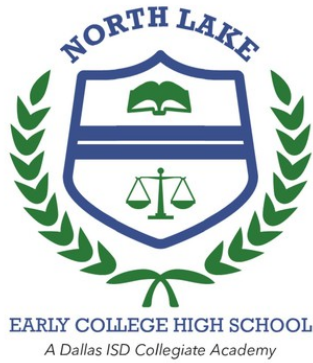
