Yearbook/ Newspaper had their annual photo booth and a potluck for members to get together and enjoy some food and each others company.





Holi - The Hindu Festival of Colors

With winter coming to an end, millions of Hindus around the world, on March 8th, will be celebrating Holi. This festival marks a new beginning of spring and signifies the triumph of good over evil. Like many festivals, there is a popular legend associated with Holi. It is said that there was a powerful king named Hiranyakashipu. He was nefarious and hated for his cruelty. Like many greedy kings, he wanted everyone in his kingdom to worship him. However, his son Prahlada refused to worship his father because he was loyal to Lord Vishnu. Upset with his sons deviance, Hiranyakashipu tried killing his son several times. He efforts, futile, so he asked his evil sister Holika to do the job. Holika possessed a special power of being immune to fire; to kill Prahlada they plotted to burning him alive. Due to the evil intensions Holika no longer possed her power and instead burned to ashes while Prahlada gained the immunity. Thus, there is a celebration of good winning over evil. Another legend representing the origins of Holi, is the love story betewen Radha and Krishna. Krishna was afraid that his dark color skin would rule him undesirable from his love Radha. His mother advises him to color Radhas face, representing their love for each other. In some parts the festival begins the night before in a celebration known as Holika Dahan where people gather around the pyre, perform puja (prayers) and light it. It is tradition that Hindus throw colored powder at each other and gather to the streets to sing, dance, and celebrate this festival of love, color, and spring.






