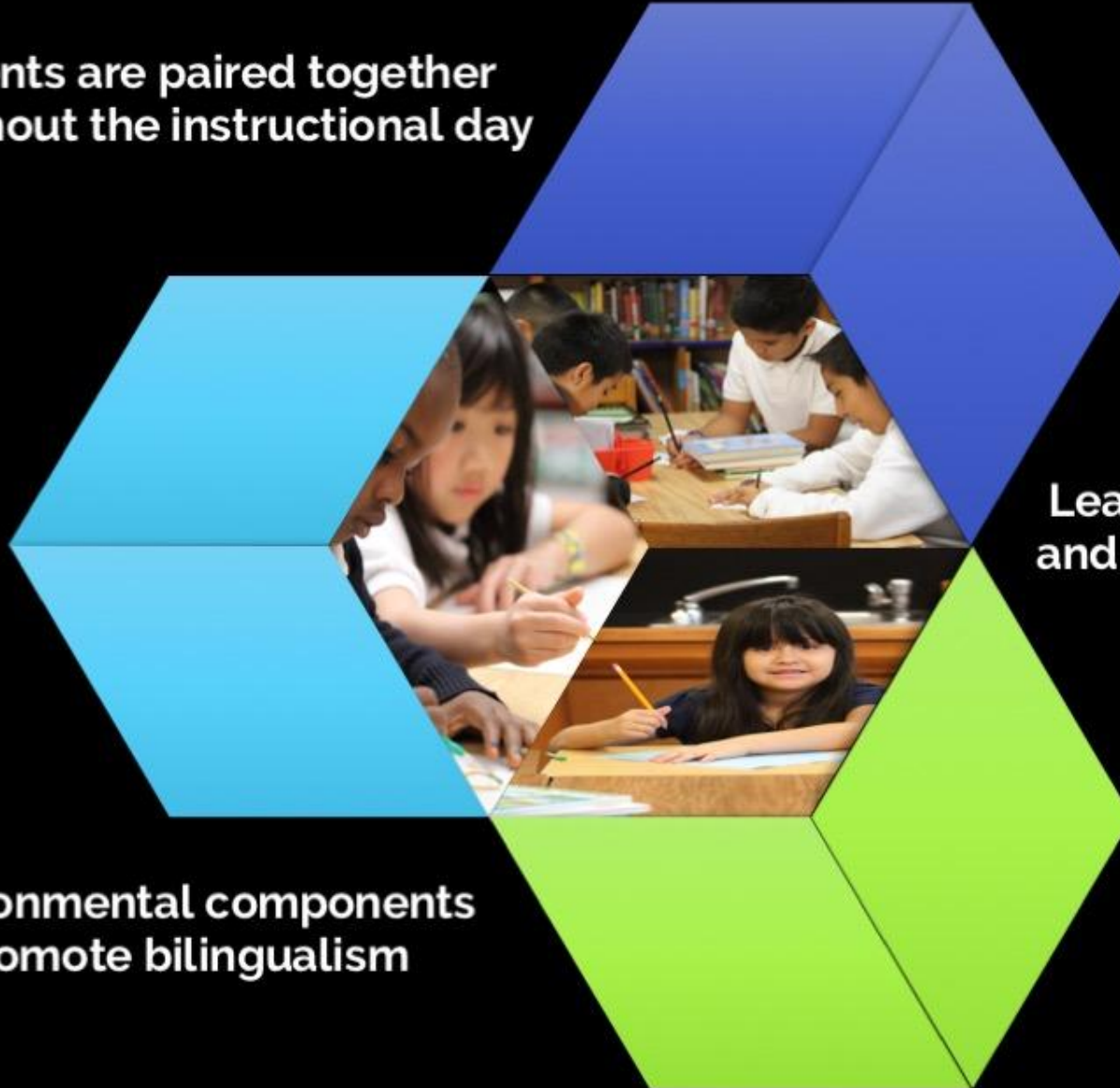

TWO-WAY DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION

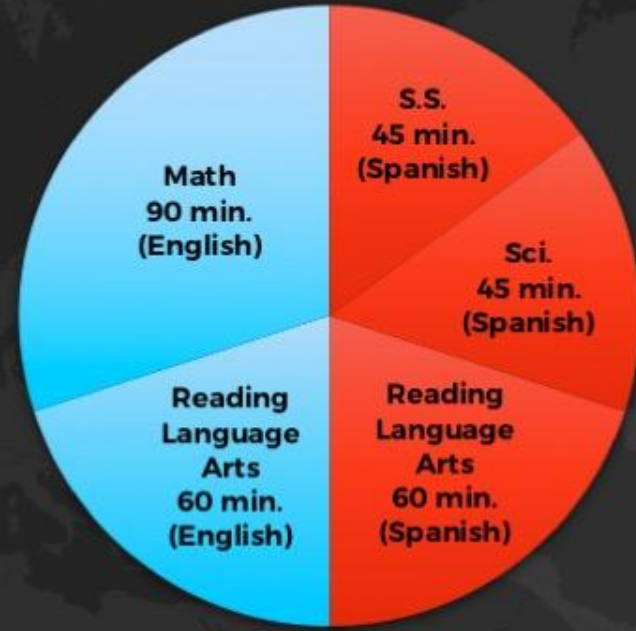
LANGUAGE DISTRIBUTION PER CONTENT AREA

- Reading/LA (Spanish)
- S.S. (Spanish)
- Science (Spanish)
- Math (English)

- Students receive initial literacy in Spanish
- Native English and Native Spanish speakers learn to read and write in Spanish
- Both Native English and Native Spanish Learners receive Math instruction in English and Science and Social Studies in Spanish

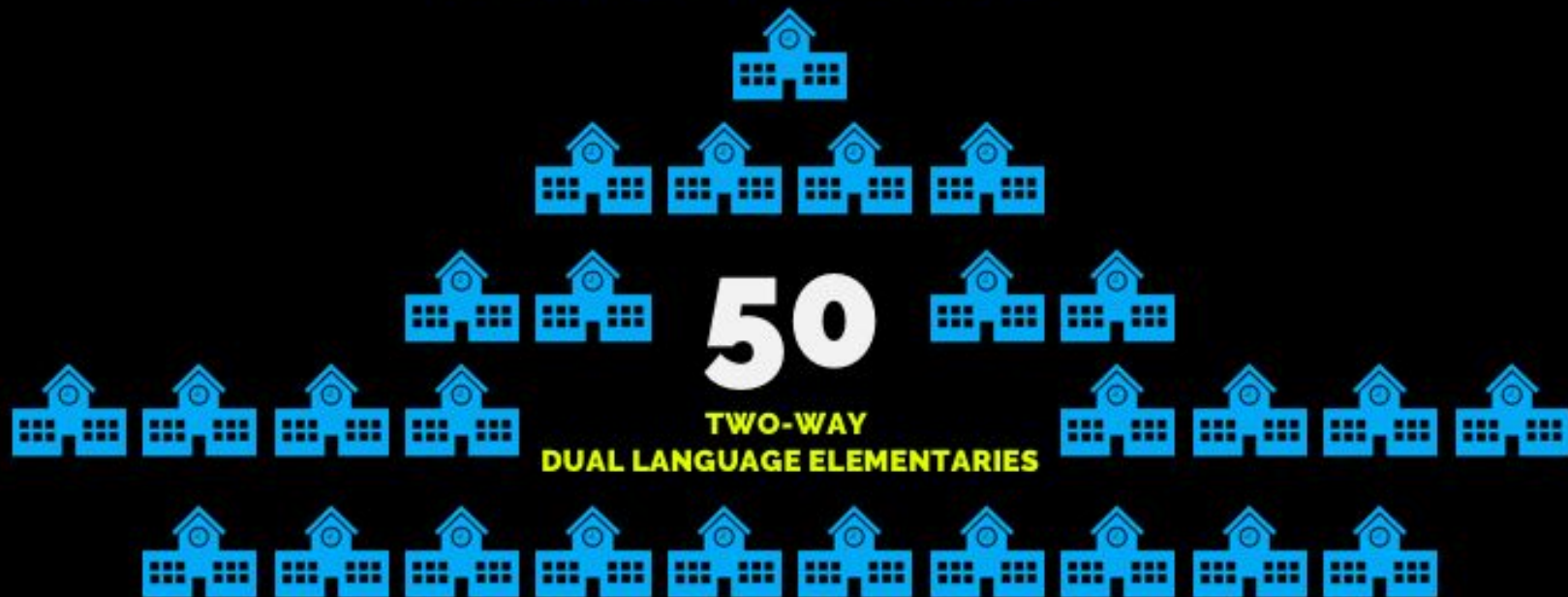

The Two-Way Dual Language program provides opportunities for all students regardless of their native language

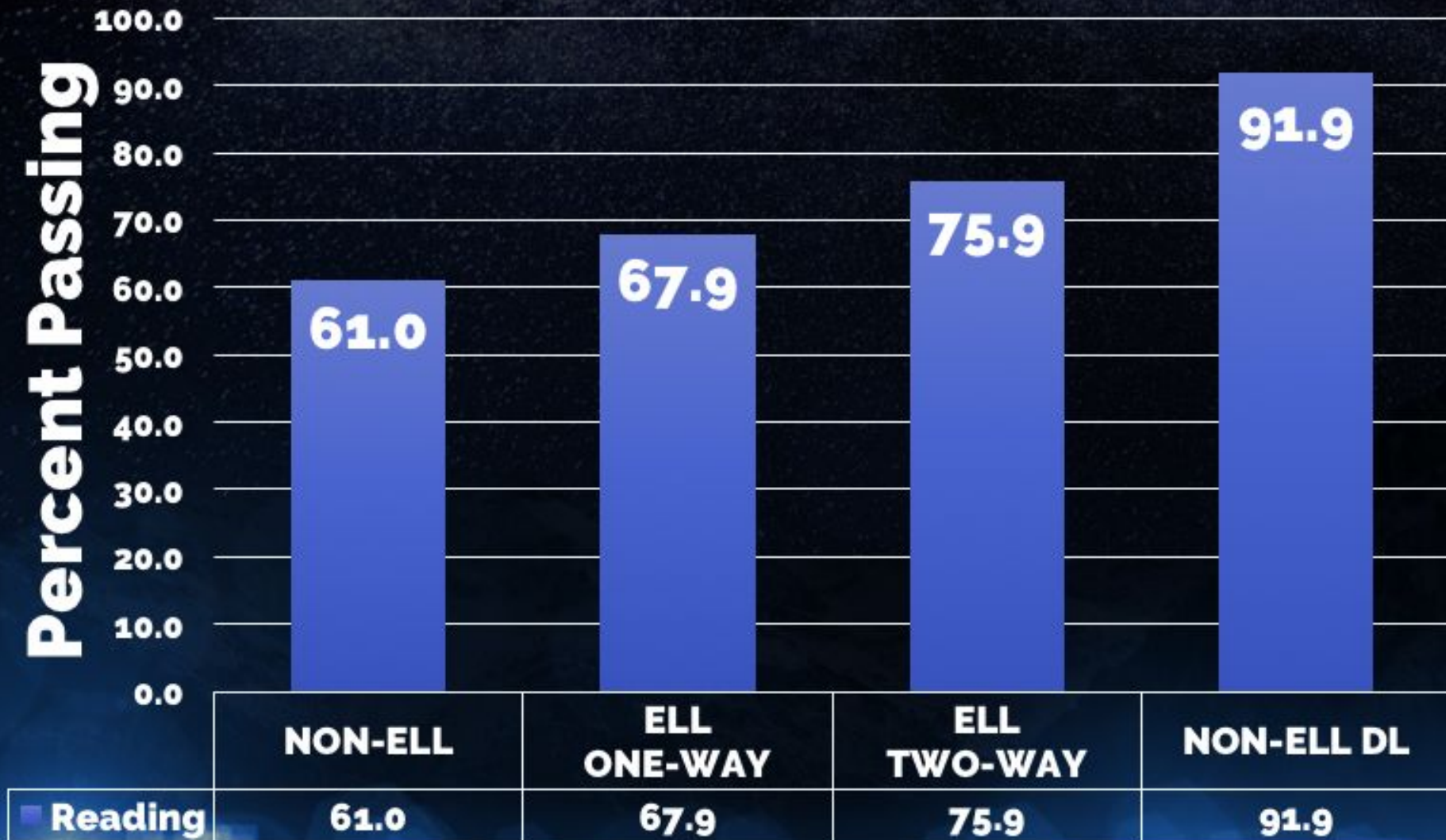
Students obtain a second language
