Purpose

Summer Bridge assists incoming 9th graders with the transition from middle school to the P-TECH/ECHS high school environment. This opportunity prepares students for the early college high school experience.

Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA2)

The college will use the following minimum passing standards to determine a student's readiness to enroll in freshman-level academic coursework. **Note: The TSIA2 requirements changed in January 2021.*

Instrument	State TSIA2 English Language Arts Standard	State TSIA2 Math Standard
TSIA2 Assessment	ELAR Score of 945+ <u>AND</u> Essay Score of 5 – 8 OR ELAR Score under 945 <u>AND</u> ELAR Diagnostic Level of 4 - 6 <u>AND</u> Essay Score of 5 – 8	*950 or above OR Math Score Under 950 <u>AND</u> Math Diagnostic Level of 6

Student Eligibility Requirements for Dual Credit: Students must complete a pre-assessment activity and practice test prior to taking the official Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA2). To be eligible for enrollment in a dual credit course offered by a public college, students must meet all the college's regular prerequisite requirements designated for that course (e.g., a minimum score on the TSIA2 test, minimum grade in a specified previous course, etc.).
