Policies and Procedures

Classroom Expectations

- * Students will enter the classroom on-time and begin working on the pre-lesson assignment and/or gathering materials for class
- * Students will bring all necessary supplies and assignments to every class, every day.
- * Students will stay on task and participate in class discussions and activities.
- * Students will be respectful, polite and kind to others.
- * Student will raise their hand for permission to speak or leave their seat.
- * Students will keep their hands, feet and other objects to themselves.

Consequences (Not meeting expectations)

all offenses will result in parent communication (phone call/email)

- * 1st Offense: Verbal Warning/Behavior Reflection/Parent phone call
- * 2nd Offense: Referral - Lunch Detention/GLA Notification/Parent phone call
- * 3rd Offense: Referral - After School Detention with GLA/Parent phone call
- * 4th Offense: Referral to Asst. Principal/Parent phone call

Attendance

Every Day is important! Student success in their classes is directly related to how often they are present. The school opens at 7:05am and their **first class STARTS promptly at 7:45am**, please ensure students are on campus and ready to work at this time. If they are eating breakfast on campus, please plan to allow time for them to do that and still get to class by 7:45a.

If students are absent or late, it is their responsibility to get the work and notes that they missed. One school day for each day of absence will be allowed for completion of missed work. For a lengthy absence, student/parent and teacher can arrange a schedule to complete missed work.

Homework/Classwork

- * Complete classwork during designated class time
- * Read daily outside of class for 20-30 minutes
- * Study vocabulary from all classes during the week
- * Work on homework and projects as assigned
- * Study for scheduled assessments
- * **Any student who does not complete work or receives a failing grade will be assigned a mandatory visit to Eagle Academy to obtain mastery of the content. Failure to attend Eagle Academy will result in disciplinary consequences including after-school discipline and suspension.**

Late Work

If students turn in assignments late, points will automatically be deducted from the assignment. Additional points maybe taken off if the assignment did not meet the criteria or if incorrect answers are submitted.

Eagle Academy

Eagle Academy is mandatory. It is assigned when a student does not complete their work, receives a failing grade on an assignment or has an overall failing grade in a class. This is not a punishment for the student but an opportunity to complete/redo the work to ensure they have mastery of the topic. Eagle Academy is held daily after school Monday through Thursday and you will be notified via email or voicemail that your child has been assigned to Eagle Academy. If a student fails to attend Eagle Academy when assigned, they will continue to be assigned Eagle Academy and will also be assigned to After School Discipline. Absence from After School Discipline will result in a suspension from school.

Academic Dishonesty

There is a zero tolerance for academic dishonesty. Any student caught cheating will earn a zero on the assignment, without the ability to redo the assignment and parent contact will be made. Students will also receive a referral for academic dishonesty.

Dress Code

Dress code will be strictly enforced this year. PLEASE review the Student Handbook to familiarize yourself with the guidelines which include not only uniforms but also jewelry, hair, grooming, etc. Failure to comply with the dress code requirements will result in disciplinary actions.
