Austin Prep enrolls approximately 800 students in grades 6-12 and employs 75 faculty.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The **Director of Music** reports to the Chair of Art and Design and is responsible for leading a comprehensive musical program in all grades, including both vocal and instrumental music. They are responsible for building and maintaining a charismatic and dynamic environment focused on growing the music program in new and innovative ways for both the band and choir.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Safeguarding the Catholic identity and mission of Austin Preparatory School and developing a comprehensive curriculum for both the band and choir programs.
- Supporting the liturgical life of Austin Prep and Campus Ministry through the selection of appropriate and engaging music. Selecting musical pieces for the choir to perform based on the venue and occasion, including Lessons and Carols in the Christmas season, a Spring Concert, and various masses and showcases throughout the academic year.
- Fostering dynamic spiritual musical leadership that maximizes the gifts of the band and choir while incorporating opportunities for participation for the entire school community.
- Traveling to Rome and other sites, both internationally and domestically, for student performances.
- Identifying and selecting suitable choir and band members, scheduling and conducting regular rehearsals, and ensuring that members utilize proper technique and decorum at all rehearsals and performances.

- Coordinating and managing all aspects of performances, including scheduling, venue arrangements, and promotion.
- Managing and maintaining instruments, equipment, and musical libraries for both the band and choir programs.
- Collaborating with other staff members, including teachers, administrators, and support staff, to support the overall goals of the organization.
- Communicating regularly with parents and community members regarding program activities, performances, and opportunities for involvement.

- Bachelor's degree in Music Education, Music Performance, or a related field (Master's degree preferred).
- Prior experience directing bands and choirs in an educational or community setting.
- Strong musical proficiency and knowledge of a variety of musical styles and genres.

- Organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Patience, flexibility, and a passion for music education.
