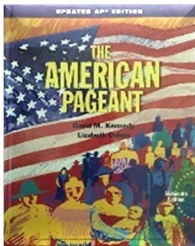

There will also be a test covering the material from the textbooks, and the written notes may be used during the test. For the assignment, students must complete the following:

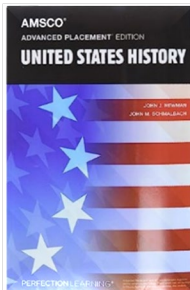
#### Assignment

- Read the following from the textbooks:
  - *The American Pageant*, Chapters 1-5, pp. 4-100

- Take detailed notes on the following prompts:
  - Name 5 key Mesoamerican societies that thrived before the arrival of Columbus in 1492
    - What are some of their key achievements?
  - In what ways was the Spanish colonization of North America similar and different from the later colonization by the English?
  - What was the Columbian Exchange, and how did it shape both the Europeans and indigenous peoples?

- How did each of the following English colonial groups develop? What characteristics differentiate each group from one another?
  - Jamestown (Virginia)
  - Plymouth and the New England colonies
  - Mid-Atlantic (New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania)
  - Chesapeake colonies (Maryland, Delaware)
  - Carolinas and Georgia
- How did society begin to evolve and develop in the mid-to-late colonial era?
  - What was the significance of the following events?
    - King Philip's War
    - Bacon's Rebellion
    - The First Great Awakening

- ***We Shall Remain: After the Mayflower***

- Watch the first episode of the PBS series on Native American History, *We Shall Remain*. The episode is entitled *We Shall Remain: After the Mayflower*
  - After watching the film, complete the following writing assignment:
  - *In one paragraph of 6-8 sentences, explain HOW and WHY the relationship between the Wampanoag and the colonists changed from the beginning of contact in 1620 through the 1670s.*
