f. School Corporation Financial Status Review

Pursuant to Indiana code 20-19-7-4 the board has been presented with a written report, using the established state fiscal indicators, of the school corporation.

The following is summary of the Analysis of Financial Condition: The corporation's financial condition still remains sound.

2020-21 showed the lowest rate of free and reduced since 2013 Relatively no change in the Special Education Rate.

The corporation showed a 5.1% increase in net assessed value as shown in the report.

Enrollment showed a slight increase a recovery to the loss during the previous pandemic years. It will be interesting to see if this increase continues with the current pandemic numbers or again starts to reverse. Fund balances continue to increase indicating fiscal oversight on the part of the corporation.

Deficit/Surplus showed revenues just falling short of expenditures but improving compared to 2019 once again indicating the solid financial strength of the corporation.

Revenue has remained consistent and indications from the state's government are for education funding to remaining relatively flat the next two years (2022 and 2023).
