- Call to order 6:05 p.m.
- Welcome & Introductions
- Review Minutes
 - Due to tonight's meeting platform (all participants via Zoom), December minutes will be reviewed next month along with the current meeting minutes
 - Currently working towards having monthly meeting minutes posted on the school's website for public access. Per Mr. Williams, once the new secretary is hired, that will be one of his/her roles to update the website
- Principal's Report
 - Flexibility with PTO meetings is of importance (offer in person & Zoom option) to strive to accommodate all
 - First virtual snow day was a success with scholars, parents, & all staff
 - Continue to reiterate that Chromebooks go home daily, store in a safe location, charge nightly, & return to school the following day for in class usage
 - Mitigating strategies for health/safety: mask required to cover the nose, maintain 3 feet distance, face forward when eating in the cafeteria, immediately put mask back on once done eating
 - Second marking period ends Thursday 1/20/2022 & report cards go home Wednesday 2/2/2022, continuing to encourage students to finish the marking period strong
