Coast Guard Program 1st's:

Our Academic Team represented LBHS on the National Stage this summer attending the JROTC Leadership and Academic Bowl. This is a national competition of the top 3% of all JROTC programs around the world, only 105 teams out of 3500 were represented.

The Color Guard Team was the first Coast Guard program to compete at the National level in competition in Daytona Beach, FL at The Nationals Drill Team Championships.

17 Cadets participated in the 1st Coast Guard Junior Leadership Academy held in Elizabeth City, NC in June. This will be an annual event focused on teaching advanced leadership and providing opportunity for cadets to practice these skills. All 6 of the current CGJROTC programs were represented.

The unit completed over 400 community service hours and looks forward to breaking the 500 hour mark in the 2023 – 2024 school year.

This was the first year of competition for the 10 – Meter Air Rifle team. With an average finish of 4th out of 15 teams in the tri-county area and twice taking top shooter awards, you could say it was an outstanding year!!!!
