## 223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

<p>1. <i>Purpose</i></p> <p>2. <i>Authority</i></p> <p>3. <i>Delegation of Responsibility</i></p>	<p>The Board regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.</p> <p>The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students have followed established procedures and obtained the required permit.</p> <p>The Board shall not be responsible for motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p> <p>The building Principal or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.</p> <p>The building Principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules, may result in revocation of the permit.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Driving to and from school – Students that desire to use transportation other than school buses must complete a Vehicle Registration Form or Passenger Parental Permission Form. Forms can be obtained in the High School Office. The following procedure is currently in effect: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Secure, complete and submit the form to the office.</li> <li>b. Student vehicles will park only in the student designated areas.</li> <li>c. Students will not be permitted to go to the parking areas to move their vehicles during the school day without permission of Administration.</li> <li>d. Students leaving school property must obtain office permission.</li> <li>e. No passengers other than those authorized by the office may be carried.</li> <li>f. Only licensed vehicles are permitted on school property.</li> <li>g. All traffic laws that apply while traveling in a school zone must be obeyed.</li> <li>h. Violations of rules will result in the suspension of privileges and disciplinary action.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Students who drive to school do so with the permission of the Administration. This is a privilege, not a right, and may be withdrawn at any time.</li> <li>3. Students must park their cars in the assigned space.</li> <li>4. It is expected that all students will drive carefully. Reports of reckless driving will result in the loss of driving privileges.</li> </ol>
