## **Athletic Emergency Action Plan (Off-Site)**

**Emergency Personnel:** Certified Athletic Trainer or Team Coach(es)

**Emergency Equipment:** First Aid, splints & CPR Mask

**Role of First Responders:**

- Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete.
- Activation of EMS:
- Call 911 (from land line or cell phone).
- Provide your name, address or location, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, treatment being provided, venue directions, and any other information that is requested.
- Designate individual to “flag down” ambulance and direct to scene.
- Open all appropriate doors and gates.
- Control the scene by limiting access to only first aid providers.
