xecutive Session

At 6:09 pm. Mr. Marasco made a motion to go into Executive Session. The purpose of which was to interview for an Assistant Principal at the John S. Charlton School. Mr. Failing seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously 3-0 (Marelli, Failing, and Marasco).

Presentation

Evelyn Brown of DEMA (Delaware Emergency Management Agency) and the Board presented certificates to CRHS, FMS, PMS, ABM, AF, MCEE, WEL, NHS, JSC, WBS, WRB, and SH for being in compliance with their School Safety Plan. Caesar Rodney School District had 100% compliance for school safety. Kimberly Chandler gave remarks thanking school principals for everything they do to keep students safe. She also reminded the school district to look into the 5 million dollar school safety grant set aside by the governor and state legislature to improve the safety of schools in the state of Delaware.

The Caesar Rodney School Board also presented principals with a small token of appreciation, a portfolio, for Principal Appreciation Month.

John S. Charlton School Principal, Michelle Flanders, with the assistance of her students selected for the Project Search program gave a presentation that highlighted their individual passions, future goals, what they have learned while in the program and what activities they had completed while in the program. Mrs. Flanders then shared with the board baskets students had created to share that included handmade gifts of wrapping paper, seasonal cards, soaps and necklaces made by students in Art, Life Science, and the Roads to Success Program at Charlton.

Mrs. Flanders accepted a presentation from Tajesh Patel and Shiv Patel to the John S. Charlton Sensory Room. Ms. Flanders explained that the sensory environment helps regulate the emotions of students. Mrs. Flanders attributed much of the student's success to the kind and generous donation of our community partners.

Tara Faircloth, Director of Curriculum and Instruction gave a presentation on the 2017-2018 State Assessments data recently released. Mrs. Faircloth discussed ESSA and the measures ESSA uses to quantify student achievement. Mrs. Faircloth shared the district's test scores and what The District's Division of Curriculum and Instruction is working on to address concerns with the test scores. She also explained that the state would be identifying CSI and TSI schools in the next week. Dr. Fitzgerald further explained the CSI and TSI labels and that 66 schools are projected to be identified as CSI or TSI schools.

- 3. We are currently working to meet the class size mandate but believe that we will once again do that without the need to request a waiver.
- 4. I want to thank all those involved in our ribbon cutting, stadium dedication and groundbreaking ceremony I particularly want to thank Dr. Kijowski and her team and Mr. Starke.
- 5. I want to Thank Dr. Toles- Torain and her team for another successful Rider Pride Day Hot Dog count was around 2500 we think there were at least 3000.
- 6. I want to thank Mrs. Rapp and the Caesar Rodney Student Government for another successful homecoming parade topped off by the first Rider victory on the turf field.
- 7. I want to congratulate our District Teacher of Year Mrs. Ashlee Upp for the way that she represented Caesar Rodney in the State Competition.
- 8. I want to say thank you to the National Association of School Superintendents For the recognition as National Superintendent of the Year I hope I represented Caesar Rodney and Delaware well during my time in Washington.
