### Opening

### Call to Order

At 7:04 p.m. School Board President Jessica Marelli called the February 20, 2018 Caesar Rodney School District regular meeting to order.

## Adoption of Agenda

Ms. Darisa Everett, Principal of Nellie Hughes Stokes Elementary School, introduced the young gents and the step team. The young gents stated their mission statement. They represent positive role models at the school. The step team did a few routines for the Board. President Marelli thanked both groups for their performances.

### Communications

### Superintendent

Dr. Fitzgerald communicated the following to the Board:

 Dr. Fitzgerald shared sad news regarding some Caesar Rodney School District friends and icons. Neil Postlethwait who served as superintendent from 1961-67 and then from 1971-89 passed away after a long illness, Mary O'Conner, retired chemistry teacher and department chair died suddenly last Sunday, Carol Shockley, who greeted students in the high school cafeteria for the last 20 years passed away suddenly at Kent General, Mike King, former elementary math and science teacher, assistant coach on the 1984 State Championship Boys Basketball Team and who went on to be a coach and athletic trainer at Del State and the University of Delaware passed away on February 9<sup>th</sup>, and Madelyn Marie Kerpen, Ken Stark's granddaughter, passed away on February 14<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Fitzgerald asked that we keep them all in our prayers.

- Dr. Fitzgerald spoke about the events that took place in Florida at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. He stated they were truly horrific. He knows that each and every educator in the Caesar Rodney School District does everything within their power to provide an environment in which our students are safe. We plan, drill and do exercises. We have upgraded the safety precautions in our buildings and will continue to do so this summer. We are exploring putting constables in our schools and increasing the number of mental health counselors on staff. We will continue to remain diligent and to listen to our children. He is aware that a National School Walkout Day is circulating on Facebook. The News Journal has already called for a quote, but he hasn't given one. As a superintendent, it is his responsibility is to make sure that the children sent to us each day receive the best possible education and to do all in his power to keep them safe. As a former social studies teacher, he is proud that students have paid attention in class and understand that they have a voice that needs to be heard. However, he cannot support allowing students to disrupt the educational setting by leaving their classrooms for a walk out. Instead, he believes they should use what they have learned in class to write or call their legislators to let their opinions be known and most importantly, he encourages them to vote when they come of age.
- Dr. Fitzgerald informed the School Board and our parents that we have taken precautionary steps when addressing the flu. Unfortunately, it hasn't run its course. School nurses have instructed students about the proper way to cough and sneeze and the importance of washing their hands. Our custodians have spent evenings disinfecting classrooms and they are constantly disinfecting high traffic areas. He reminded everyone that if your child is running a fever, is nauseas, or not feeling well, to please keep them home. He reminded the staff members that this also applies to them. We will continue to do all we can. More information can be found on the CR website.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated our wrestling team on winning the dual meet state championship. The first since 2014. He wished the wrestlers, who qualified for the individual state champions held this weekend, the best of luck.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated Destiny Bailey-Perkins, who repeated as indoor long jump champion.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated the boy's swim team for winning the Henlopen Conference Championship, the girl's team for finishing second and coach Maureen VanOrman for once again being recognized by the conference as the outstanding boy's coach.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated all of our athletes who have sign letters of commitment over the last two weeks and all of our seniors who have received their college acceptance letters.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated the CR Alumni Class of 73's Tom Wagner on his retirement from state office. After 29 years he has decided not to run for re-election as State Auditor.
- Dr. Fitzgerald congratulated our Chinese Immersion students on their performance at the Chinese Cultural Arts
  Festival and he thanked the parents for giving up their time over a long weekend so that their children could
  participate in this event.
- Dr. Fitzgerald notified the Board he will be attending the Chief's Spring Conference on March 1st and 2nd.
- Dr. Fitzgerald announced that W.B. Simpson will be having their Community Appreciation Breakfast on March 8<sup>th</sup> and the CRHS Thespians will perform *The Music Man* March 8<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> with several elementary students appearing in the production. CREA will have their Social on March 2<sup>nd</sup> at Dover Downs which supports student scholarships.
- Dr. Fitzgerald reminded the Board that the filing deadline for school board is 4:30 p.m. on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Currently two candidates have filed, Dr. John Moore and Mr. Bill Victory.

He mentioned the positive things going on in the district and stated he was proud to be a member of the Board.
