2023-24 accomplishments we are proud to celebrate, because of the impact on learning and teaching for each and every learner.

- We offer 32 AP classes. One third of all CHS students took at least one Advanced Placement (AP) exam. 502 CHS students took a total of 872 AP exams in the 23-24 school year.
- 100% of AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) elective students were accepted to a 4-year institution for the third year in a row.
- Offering a comprehensive list of extracurricular offerings in the Arts, Activities, and Athletics - 63% of our Chaska High School students participate annually in a fee-based school program offering.
- 7 National Merit Scholars (3 Finalists, 1 Semifinalists, 3 Commended)
- 87% of students responding to our spring end of year survey agreed or strongly agreed with the statement "I am seen, heard, valued, and respected for who I am and who I want to be."
- 81% of families responding to our spring end of year survey agreed or strongly agreed with the statement " My child's education helps them grow as a person, not just academically, and prepares them for whatever path they choose after high school."
- \$135,000 in community-supported scholarships were presented to our Class of 2024 graduates.
