

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Upper Twp Middle School

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing (did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 10/1/23-12/31/23 we did not do sample for Radiologicals for well #1, Treatment Plant TP00100 and Well#2, Treatment Plant TP002002, therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The Laboratory neglected to take the required samples during the period on 10/1/23- 12/31/23

What is being done?

There is nothing else to do at this time. New samples were taken, we are awaiting results, but historical data on this testing have not shown any irregularities, we do not anticipate any problems now.
