

Pre-K Counts Parent, Guardian & Visitor Code of Conduct:

In order to maintain an orderly, respectful and secure educational environment for the students and staff of the Pre-K Counts Program, it is essential that all parents, guardians, and visitors to our program be aware of their responsibilities and adhere to the expected code of conduct as set forth in this Pre-K Counts Handbook.

Parent, Guardian and Visitors are expected to:

- Respect the caring attitude and values of our program
- Understand that both staff, parents, guardians and visitors need to work together for the benefit of all children
- Get their children to the program on time and pick up their children from the program on time
- Act as a role model for all children, set a good example with child friendly speech (NO PROFANITY), respectfully behave, and all should be dressed with underclothing not displayed
- Know the program and classroom rules and help their children to understand them
- Park in the assigned parking areas only- in the lot only-NEVER NEXT TO THE CURB!!!
- Follow all laws and MASD policies and procedures (no weapons, drugs, gambling, fighting, threatening others, smoking on school property etc...)

Parents, Guardians, and Visitors should refrain from:

- Disruptive, disrespectful and disorderly conduct on any MASD school property
- Making threats to and/or slandering staff members, other parents, guardians and visitors in person, via text, and/or any other social media outlet
- Selling anything to staff, other parents & guardians for fundraisers and/or personal gain
- Destroying school property (pounding, kicking, hitting the doorbells and/or the doors)
- Touching anyone connected to the Pre-K Counts Program with the intent to cause harm or to intimidate
- Verbal Confrontations

Persons in Violation of the Code of Conduct could be:

- Given a warning about their inappropriate choice(s)
- For attendance violations (late pick-ups and repeated absences) students could be removed from the program automatically
- Banned from returning to the program/school property
- Turned into the authorities
