Overview:

Today more than ever technology is increasingly becoming more important in the day-to-day education of students. For the 2021-2022 school year it will be a necessity that every student has a device that they can use in the classroom as well as at home. To facilitate this emerging need McKeesport Area School District is proud to offer a Chromebook lending program for students in grades 3 through 12. The lending program is offered by request and will not require mandatory participation. In lieu of a district owned device, students in grades 3 through 12 may elect to bring their personally owned Chromebooks or personal computing device (BYOD) to school daily.

Policy Information:

For students in grades 3-12, District policy requires students who are opting to request a district issued Chromebook, to purchase the annual non-refundable insurance policy. The fee is \$20.00 per student loaned device requested and is enrolled and managed through the district’s insurance program’s website at <http://one2onerisk.com>. For families who cannot or do not wish to enroll with a personal debit or credit card, insurance vouchers can be purchased for the \$20.00 enrollment cost.

With the insurance the student will be expected to pay an increasing deductible based on the table below. Deductibles and claims reset yearly. After the 4th incident the deductible is the full replacement cost for the device and the student will be unenrolled in the lending program without a refund of the insurance cost.

The deductible schedule is as follows:

Accidental Damage Claim #1 of the current academic year	\$ 0.00
Accidental Damage Claim #2 within the same academic year	\$25.00
Accidental Damage Claim #3 within the same academic year	\$50.00
Lost or Stolen Claim with parent provided Police Report	\$100.00

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device):

For students wishing to bring their own device, those devices will be the sole responsibility of the student and the district will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged devices. Additionally, the district will not provide any technical support for non-District owned devices. McKeesport Area School District employees are not permitted to install software on any non-District owned device. Non-District owned devices are only permitted to connect to the MASD Guest wireless network. Cell phones are not permitted to be used as part of the bring your own device program.

If a student decides to request a district-issued Chromebook later in the school year, they may request to do so by enrolling in the insurance program and making an appointment for device pickup through their building specific process.
