Can I take Dual Credit English?

Students (juniors & seniors) need qualifying ACT/SAT or Accuplacer scores and a Parent permission form to take Dual Credit English through Trident Tech.

Is there a cost?

No Tuition or Textbook Fees!

By taking 2 courses/semester (ex. English 101/102), students automatically qualify for the South Carolina Lottery tuition assistance and the course is free.

Be advised, you must earn a "C" (71%) or higher in English 101 to move onto English 102.

Dual Credit vs. AP?
What should I take?

Dual Credit Courses:

- No high stakes exam to earn college credit
- Honors level - 5.0 scale
- 9-week long courses
- Earn 2 high school credits & 6 college credit hours at the same time
- Interesting topics and readings

What else do I need to know?

Dual Credit Courses:

- Composition courses (essays)

*English 101 is a prerequisite for English 102. Students must earn a 71% or higher (C) in English 101 to move onto English 102.

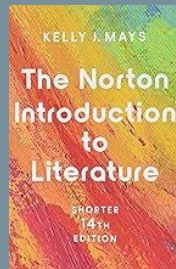
