Public Comments	<p>A district parent asked about contact tracing and how it will be tracked in the event of a positive test.</p> <p>A district parent who has a child with asthma encouraged mask use.</p> <p>Greg Willson, S-C High teacher, asked the board to consider mask protocols as he lives with two co-morbidities that put him at greater risk of COVID-19.</p> <p>Cindy Calafaty, Parkview music teacher, expressed happiness that the district has not eliminated fine art classes while expressing worries over singing's ability to spread the virus.</p> <p>Anna Harvey, Parkview kindergarten teacher, talked about masks creating obstacles related to phonics education.</p> <p>Yale Barkefelt, JROTC instructor, encouraged that masks and extracurricular activities be a choice for students and their parents to make.</p> <p>JoAnn Martin, director of the Pettis County Health Center, provided current statistics for the county. She noted that young children are at the lowest risk of sharing the virus, but also the most problematic when it comes to wearing a mask. She also said the Missouri State Fair will present problems as it could become a center for transmissions with so many people in close proximity. Martin said there is encouragement to keep children in their cohort groups to allow for contact tracing, which can help limit the spread of the virus. Passing times are less of a concern than classrooms because experts believe transmissions occur when people are together for 15 minutes or more.</p>
