## **Online Learning**

The Lind and Ritzville Boards of Directors believe that a variety of learning options, including online courses and programs, are critical for 21st century learners. The boards recognize that the online learning environment provides students with unique opportunities to become self-disciplined learners with life-long learning skills. Further, the boards believe that online learning provides tremendous opportunities for students to access curriculum and specialized courses in a flexible learning environment that might not otherwise be available.

Therefore, the boards support a range of online learning opportunities that are equally accessible to all students in the school district. The boards direct the superintendent to provide information to parents, students and staff regarding online learning options and the guidelines for participation.

The superintendent or designee will develop procedures to implement this policy. The procedures will include, but not be limited to, a description of student access to online learning courses/programs, student eligibility criteria, the types of online courses available to students, methods the districts will use to support student success, payment of course fees and other costs, granting of course credit, and conditions under which no credit will be awarded.
