Extraclassroom Activity Fund Note to Financial Statements Year Ended June 30, 2012

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The transactions of the Extraclassroom Activity Fund are considered part of the reporting entity of North Tonawanda City School District.

The books and records of North Tonawanda City School District's Extraclassroom Activity Fund are maintained on the cash basis of accounting. Under this basis of accounting, revenues are recognized when cash is received and expenditures are recognized when cash is disbursed. Consequently, accounts receivable due and amounts due to others at June 30, 2012 are not included in the financial statements. The District exercises general oversight of these funds.

The cash balances of the Extraclassroom Activity accounts are also included in the basic financial statements of North Tonawanda City School District. These amounts are included in the Agency column of the Statement of Fiduciary Net Assets.
