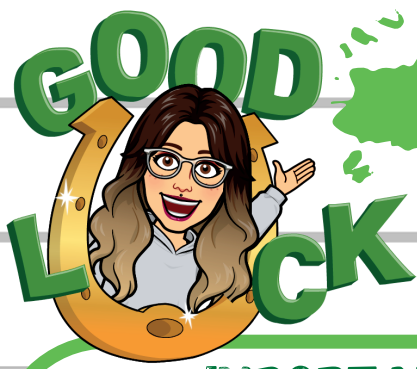

Tuesday Eat and wear ORANGE

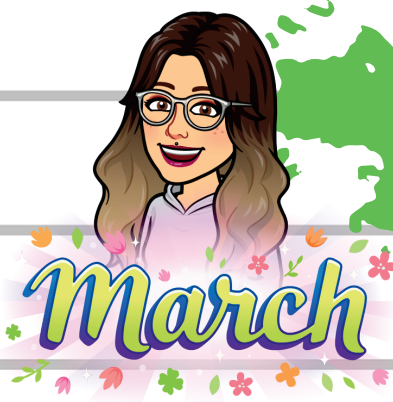

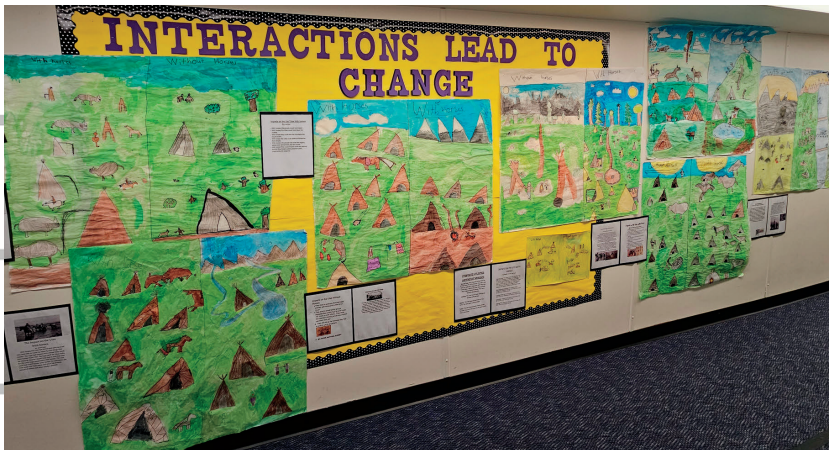


The impacts on the Utes Without Horses Oliver, Mia and Ryker

- The Utes ate rabbit deer, berries and nuts.
