CHAMPS

Aligned to the district-wide behavior matrix, expectations are clarified using the CHAMPS acronym:

The C stands for **conversation** – can learners talk to each other? How loudly? The H stands for **help** – how do learners get the attention of educators or other adults or get help if they need it? The A stands for **activity** – what are learners supposed to do? The M stands for **movement** – can learners move around? The P stands for **participation** – what does the expected behavior look like? And the S stands for **success** – if you follow CHAMPS, you will be successful!

STOIC is an acronym that provides a reminder to educators when planning for instruction and managing behavior, this is the backbone of the CHAMPS expectations.
