

What's Next for NISD CTE




- Advanced Manufacturing Program is currently in the 4th year of implementation now at all 3 High Schools.






72% of students who take an AP Exam earn credit on at least one exam.

TSIA-2 Testing




With the exception of an unusual drop in 2022-2023 we have seen a steady increase in the number of TSI Assessments given.

Dual Credit Enrollment






Associate's Degrees
