RESOLUTION 2020/2021-008**


WHEREAS, Chapter 86, Laws of 1969, as codified in RCW 39.62 authorizes the use of facsimile signatures by any public officer in lieu of a manual signature to execute any “public security” or any “instrument of payment”;

WHEREAS, the statute further requires that before any authorized officer may use a facsimile signature plate or stamp, he/she must file a manual signature with the Secretary of State, duly certified while under oath; and

WHEREAS, Deborah Rumbaugh, Ed.D., Superintendent/Secretary of the Stanwood-Camano School District Board of Directors, has filed a Certificate of Manual Signature, duly certified under oath, with the Auditor of Snohomish County,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the facsimile plate or stamp, as imprinted below, for Deborah Rumbaugh, Ed.D., Superintendent/Secretary, be accepted for use in lieu of a manual signature of any public security or any instrument of the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401, effective July 1, 2021.
