FDK Exploration Process

What work has been done already?

- Conducted research on FDK
- Presented an overview of programming to the School Board & community
- Established a timeline: Goal to implement in 2025-26 School Year
- Completed site visits
- Assessed staffing & facility needs
- Performed a financial analysis
- Created & distributed a community survey



Full Day Kindergarten: Feedback



What feedback have you received about FDK?

Staff Survey:

- Indicated Support of Full Day Kindergarten
- Perceived Benefits:
 - Enhanced academic skills
 - More time for instructional interventions
 - Better utilization of the current curriculum
 - Improved preparedness for 1st grade
- Perceived Obstacles:
 - Ensuring adequate staffing for FDK
 - Addressing space limitations

Community Survey:

- Hanover Research Conducted Survey
- Large Sample Size
- Indicated Support of Full Day Kindergarten

Special Education Considerations

How will we support our students with special needs?

- Exposure to a full day of programming provides earlier screening and supports for students
- Currently there is a "full-day" Kindergarten option for students with greater need
- Increased options for inclusivity
- Enhanced transition opportunities for students transitioning from Early Intervention

Staffing Needs



How many teachers and staff do we need to hire?

- Estimated Staffing Needs:
 - General Education Teachers: 17+
 - Specialists: 7
 - Instructional Assistants: 5
 - Support Staff: 3
 - School Psychologist
- Recruitment Process





Facility Planning

Can we fit the additional classrooms needed?

- Additional 17 classrooms can be obtained within current building footprints
- Addressing scheduling needs for Special areas and Cafeteria/Recess
- PDE does not require bathrooms in kindergarten classrooms

Financial Analysis



How will we pay for FDK?

- Furniture & classroom supplies Funding will come from General Fund fund balance committed for future educational initiatives
 - Cost estimate \$1,138,539
- Transportation: We estimate that elimination of midday runs less additional morning and afternoon runs will save \$483,000
- Food Services: Will be supplied by our third party vendor
- Staffing Cost estimate for all additional staff in 2025/2026 \$2,611,208
- Split tax increase over 2 years
 - 2024/2025 0.56% tax increase should net \$1,007,879
 - 2025/2026 Remaining tax increase to cover the rest of ongoing costs Information herein is subject to change and is for discussion purposes only.

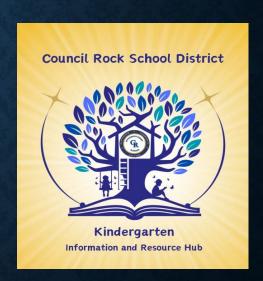


Where do we go from here?
