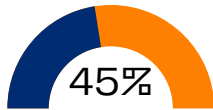

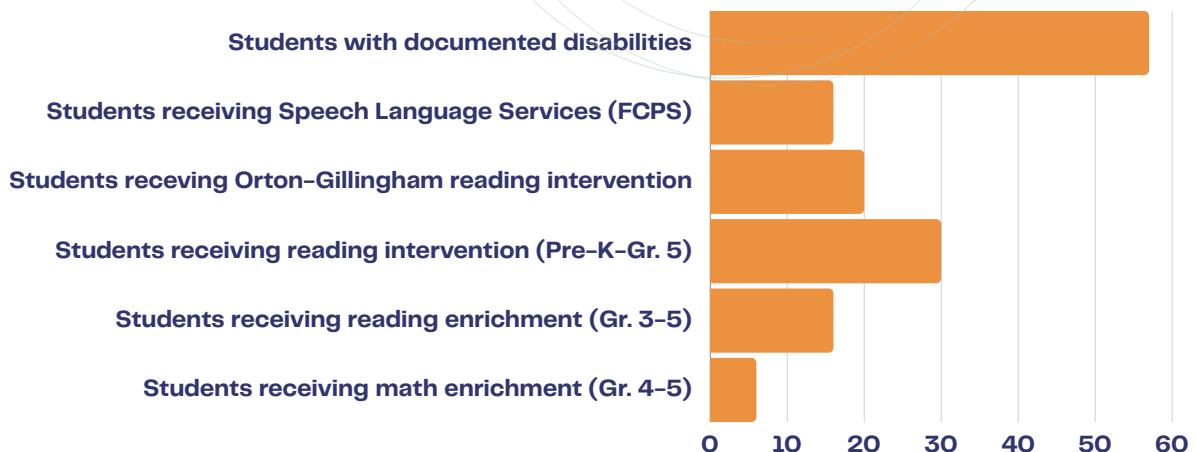

CATHOLIC SCHOOL ACADEMICS

It was with great excitement that we launched our new reading curriculum in 22-23. **Geodes® by Wilson Language and Great Minds** aligned with our K-8 English language arts curriculum, **Wit & Wisdom®**, and **Wilson Foundations®**. The books build students' confidence in their reading ability and inspire curiosity with knowledge-building topics. Geodes® not only helps emerging and struggling readers to improve their literacy skills, but introduces accelerated readers with challenging and interesting content.

Our mission to inspire our students to academic excellence was enhanced when we launched new curricula in reading and math and opened a brand new media center.

In addition to the new literacy program, MSS students in Pre-K through grade 6 began using **Singapore Math**, a highly effective and internationally regarded program that instills a deep understanding of mathematics in preparation for advanced math in higher grades.

The new **Ed and Helen Reaver Family Media Center** expanded the location of the old library by removing several walls and

increasing the space to 1484 sq ft. New tables, chairs, and shelves enhanced the renovated space, along with a large Promethean Board, 28 student Chromebooks, and five high-speed computers. Students have access to all the resources necessary to develop and hone the essential skills needed to be information-literate contributors to their communities.



CATHOLIC SCHOOL VALUES

At the heart of our mission is our dedication to inspire students to love and serve Christ in the tradition of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Vincent de Paul.

At Mother Seton School, students are immersed in a vibrant culture of faith and service. Daily prayers and religion class, Mass participation, and special events like Blessing of the Animals and outreach service projects, provide students with opportunities **to learn how to love and serve Jesus and demonstrate concrete ways to love and serve their neighbors.**

During Catholic Schools Week, students collected socks, hats,

and gloves for Frederick County shelters and donations for the Maryland Coalition of Families. Our **Archbishop James Roosevelt Bayley National Junior Honor Society** members made casseroles to be donated to the Frederick Food Bank, and demonstrated leadership by encouraging students in collecting toiletries for the Emmitsburg Food Bank, Toys for Tommy for pediatric cancer patients at Johns Hopkins,

and over 630 lbs. of food for Tabitha's Table in Smithsburg.

Our **Vincentian Marian Youth** students visited the retired Sisters, held several bake sales to assist local families in need, and performed acts of service around the school especially during Advent. During the 22-23 school year, our MSS students **raised over \$13,000 and collected hundreds of items**, demonstrating an unwavering commitment to embracing Catholic values and making a meaningful impact on the lives of others.





Parents are an important part of our MSS community. The MSS Home and School Association (H.S.A.) is our parent-led organization that demonstrates their love for our students in creative ways throughout the year.

During the 2022-23 school year, H.S.A. hosted multiple **FUN and successful FUNdraising events to support the mission of MSS.** At the end of the year, the H.S.A. presented Dr. Kilty with a check for **\$35,000** to be used for all aspects of our school community.

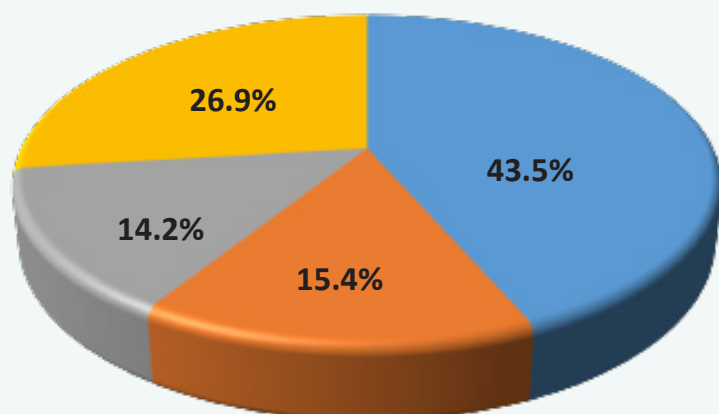

The title of Psalm 133 is "*Vision of a Blessed Community.*" Fittingly, it called to mind our Mother Seton School community, and during the rest of my travels, I contemplated this verse. I prayed for unity in our school community and that we may attain the goal of being a "blessed community." As I write this letter, I am again reminded of the Psalm.

It is unique in the way we are strongly tied to and supported by the Daughters of Charity, who exemplify the blessed community we are exhorted to strive for.
