Final ISAT Scores

I am pleased, but not satisfied to report that Emmett High School performed at or above the state average in ELA, Math, and Science. The final scores are below:

ELA—61% of our students scored proficient or advanced, and the state average was 59%.

Math—34% of our students scored proficient or advanced, and the state average was 31%.

Science—40% of our students scored proficient or advanced, and the state average was 40%.
