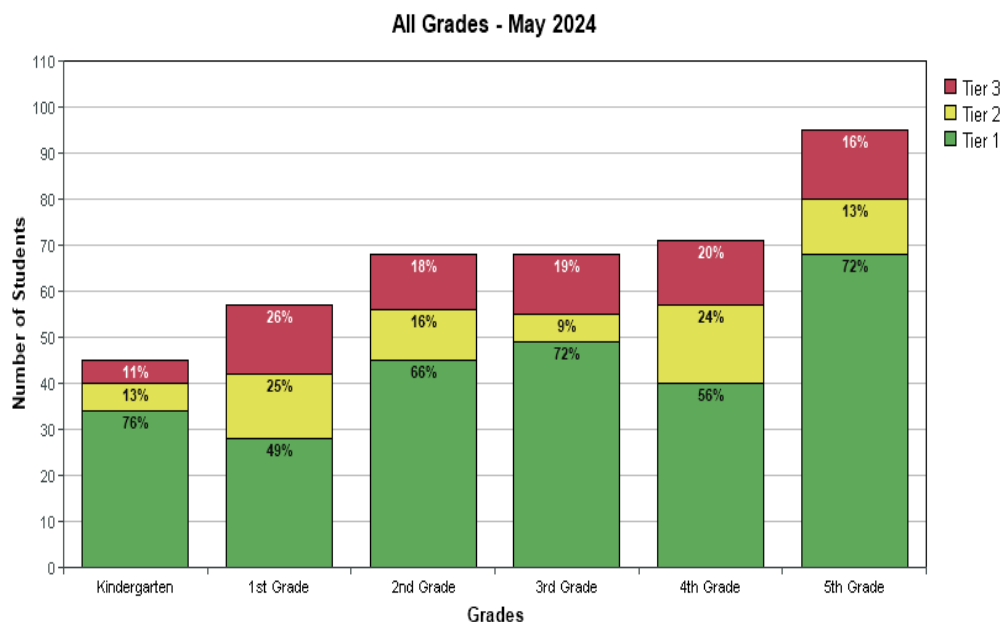

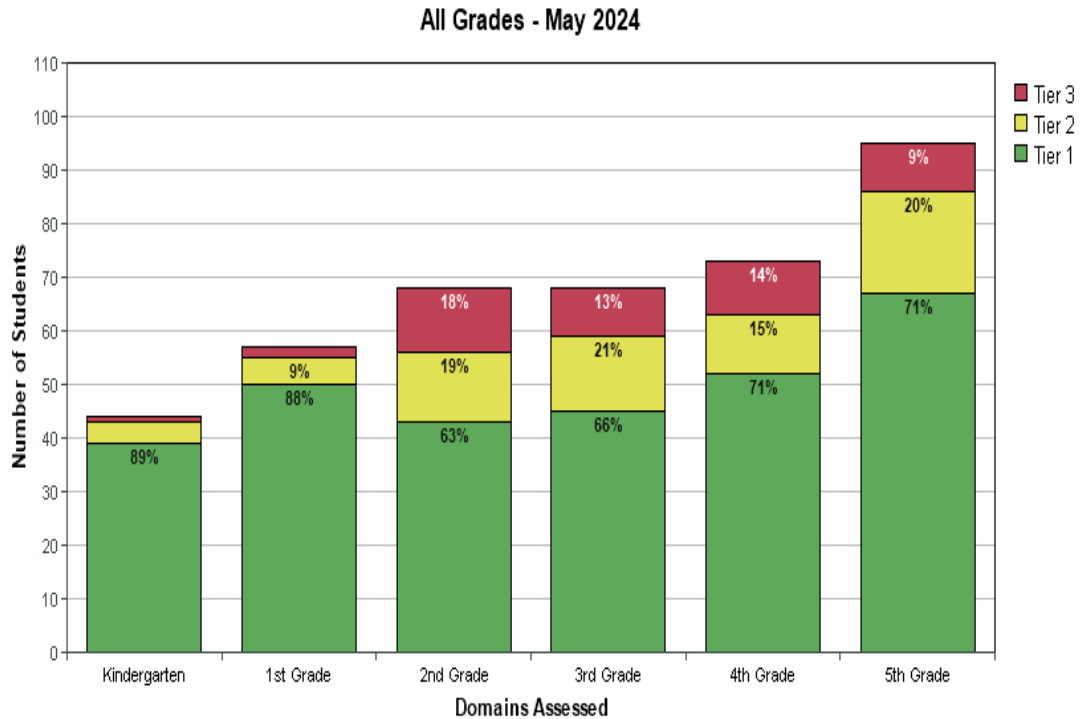
- ★ Please see the [June newsletter](#) for Carberry's end of year happenings. It was packed with fun.
