
Emmett Middle School Monthly Board Update June 2024

EMS 7th Grade had a score increase of 43 points from 2022-2023.


8th Grade Math Longitudinal report of Score Performance




Whole School ELA Scores

day. Our staff really came together to put on many different activities to keep the students active and happy. I would like to say thank you to the donor, who wishes to remain anonymous. They donated


the obstacle course and the zip line, for the students to enjoy. They were a big hit!
