

# The Hun School of Princeton Technology Initiative

The Hun School Technology Initiative provides tools for teachers and students to enhance technological literacy, promote creativity and collaboration, enable interactive and engaged learning experiences, support differentiated instruction, and make learning accessible to students from any location at any time.

Adding iPads/MacBooks to our toolboxes has opened a whole new set of possibilities for teachers and students alike. Students and faculty report great appreciation for the ubiquitous nature of classroom technology at Hun. As a school, we believe that these technology tools are indicative of the professional world our students will enter after Hun and therefore, see great benefit in making a part of their daily lives as students.

For the 2024-2025 Academic Year, all students in grades 6 to Post Graduate are required to have an iPad **or** (for Upper School only) an Apple MacBook to allow iBooks capability.

## **Product Recommendations and Requirements:**

- **Recommended Device:** For new students, we recommend optimally a **13 inch iPad Pro or iPad Air with at least 256GB** or at minimum a **10.9 inch iPad** or a MacBook Air with at least 256GB. Returning Hun students with older devices (iPad Air or older iPad models) may find limits on applications or iBooks but should be able to accomplish required school tasks with their current iPads. We also recommend students with iPads consider purchasing an [Apple Pencil](#) and [Apple's Smart Keyboard](#) for use in note-taking and other app-specific utilities that will enhance their classroom experience. **Beginning with the Class of 2025, all 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students are required to have a keyboard for their iPads in order to facilitate their Computer Science coursework.**
- **Required general applications for all students:** Please download the following applications for use on the first day of school. Keynote, Pages, and iMovie come free with all iPads but older devices may need to download from the app store:
  - Keynote- Free
  - Pages- Free
  - iMovie- Free
  - Desmos Graphing Calculator (for iPads) - Free
  - Google Sheets- Free
  - Google Docs- Free
  - Google Drive- Free
  - iBooks- Free
- **Required specific applications/books for individual courses:** In addition, certain classes have apps or iBooks that are required. Please check the Book and Application List for additional downloads that are specific to your academic program.

- **Cases and Insurance:** While not required, we encourage you to purchase AppleCare Plus or 3<sup>rd</sup> party insurance for the device in order to allow for replacement in the event of loss or breakage. Since the iPad/MacBook is not owned by The Hun School, our resources to support the devices are limited. The case of your choosing will also allow for maximum protection for your iPad/MacBook when placed in a backpack or locker.
- **Backup** - We recommend that students use Apple's iCloud, Google Drive, or the Dropbox App to back-up and store important files on their iPads/MacBooks. Apps and iBooks are automatically backed up on the iTunes account used to purchase them. If the iPad/MacBook is lost or breaks, a student could then access their work and iBooks on a temporary or new iPad/MacBook.
- **Orientation and Acceptable Use:** As part of our orientation program in September, new students will review our proper care and acceptable use policies, learn the basics of our email and RaiderNet communication system, and be oriented on how our innovative printing system works with iPads/MacBooks. **New students should make sure that you bring your iPad/MacBook to school for orientation activities on Tuesday, September 3, 2024.**
