TrueNorth was established in 1960, and over the course of its history, has helped to shape the delivery of educational services to diverse learners in the region, and on the state and national levels.

In Illinois there are 852 public school districts¹, 87% of which belong to one of the 66 special education cooperatives in the state.2

Our Facilities

TrueNorth owns the North Shore Academy, District Services Center, Arthur and Mary Rubloff, and Rhonda Alter House buildings.

TrueNorth has classrooms in district schools and community preschools.

Our member districts

TrueNorth Educational Cooperative 804 provides special education and related services, coaching and consultation to 18 member districts. Until July 1, 2021, the cooperative was called Northern Suburban Special Education District (NSSED).

TrueNorth has 18 member districts. 14 are elementary districts and four are high school districts.

There are 35,959 students in the TrueNorth member districts3. Of those students, 4,876 (13.5%) have Individualized Education Plans and receive services under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Although data is not available at a regional or state level, additional students receive services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

TrueNorth's Fiscal Year 2025 total operating revenue is budgeted at \$41.25 million:
