ELA

Activity Description- Summer Bucket List

Directions

- Brainstorm a list of activities you would like to accomplish this summer.
- Some examples are: going swimming, taking a hike, reading an entire book, going camping, seeing fireworks, making smores, and many more.

Math

Activity Description - Fraction Battle or IXL (L9R Prime and Composite up to 100)

Directions

- Create fractions using a deck of cards. You will separate the cards into red suits and black suits, using only cards with numbers. The red cards will be the numerator and the black cards the denominator. It may be helpful to put a pencil or straw in between to be your fraction line.
- Sit side by side with your partner and compare the fractions. The largest fraction wins.

Social Studies

Activity Description- Design a flag to represent you!

Directions

- Each country's flag has a story to represent the country's history. Think about what items would be on a flag that represents you.
- Get a sheet of paper and create your own flag and draw all the items and objects that represent you. Color it!
- Tell a family member why you designed the flag the way you did.
- Hang it on display in your room!

<p>Science</p>	<p>Activity Description- Lego Shadow Towers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Track the sun using a toy tower! You will need toys to build with, a piece of sidewalk chalk, and a sidewalk or driveway area to use. <p>Directions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Build a small tower, less than 12 inches tall from legos, or use any other toy you may have at home. Take your tower or toy outside in the morning and place it on a sidewalk or driveway in the sun. See where the shadow of your tower/toy goes. Trace the shadow outline with sidewalk chalk. Come back each hour to see how the shadow has grown and changed. Trace the shadow outline each hour to see how much your tower shadow changes!
