Vehicles are subject to search and to the Student Code of Conduct and Discipline.

1. Driving in a reckless fashion on or near school property.
2. Use of vehicle in "skipping" school or to leave campus without checking out (including lunch time).
3. Driving without wearing a seat belt.
4. Giving your parking permit to another student.
5. Transporting another student off campus without proper approval.
6. Parking in an area other than the designated student parking areas.
7. Excessive discipline or major discipline referral.
8. Five unexcused absences in one grading period.
9. No lingering in the parking lot before school, during lunch or after school.
10. Secure and lock your vehicle.
11. Storage of illegal items in vehicle is prohibited.
12. Replacement sticker \$10.00.
