**Not included in the tuition fee:** snacks and lunch for Secondary students (a la carte via smart card), intensive EAL program, selected ECAs, school uniforms and kits, school trips, residential trips, and school bus transportation.

**Note:** The deposit will be billed at the beginning of each academic year to cover incidental costs, and any unused amount will be refunded at the end of the academic year.

**Included in the fee:** room, all meals, academic support, and selected weekend activities.

**Not included in the fee:** airport transfer, transportation, and visa fees.

## INITIAL FEES

### Application Fee

5,500

A one-time, non-refundable fee that covers the cost of the student assessment and application process payable upon application to KIS Reignwood Park. Submitting an application does not guarantee a place.

### Registration Fee

255,000

A one-time, non-refundable fee is payable upon parents' acceptance of an invitation to join KIS Reignwood Park. A child's place at KIS Reignwood Park is only assured once this fee is settled.

### Annual Development Fee (non-refundable)

40,000

This is a non-refundable Annual Development Fee payable upon confirming a place at KIS Reignwood Park, and is due annually by the start of May to secure placement for the subsequent academic year.

OR

### School Development Fund (refundable)

250,000

This is a one-time payment that contributes towards the School Development Fund (SDF). It is an alternative to the payment of the Annual Development Fee. The payment is refundable to parents within 30 days upon graduation or notice of withdrawal by the specified withdrawal dates, after deducting any outstanding fees. Where less than one term's notice is provided, the School Development Fund will not be refunded.



## FURTHER INFORMATION

### Sibling Discounts

For Second Child

20% discount on the registration fee and a 5% discount on the tuition fee

For Third/Subsequent Child

30% discount on the registration fee and a 10% discount on the tuition fee

**Note:** The sibling discount cannot be used in combination with any other annual fee reduction.

### Conditions and Payment Schedule

The fees at KIS Reignwood Park are reviewed annually and are subject to change. Our fees reflect our commitment to excellent high academic standards, faculty and staff, and world-class facilities for your child's education.

Parents have the option to pay tuition and fees by term or annually. A discount of 2% is given for tuition and boarding fees paid annually, applied after any other annual fee reductions. Tuition and fees for all students must be paid 1 month before the start of term or immediately if starting within this timeframe.

For families opting to pay termly, payment is due by the following dates:

For new students, the registration fee and annual development fee/school development fund will be invoiced within 2 working days after accepting a place and are due within 2 weeks of the dated invoice. All fees must be paid before students can attend school.

### Late Enrollment

Students are able to start on any Monday during the school term, and tuition and boarding fees will be prorated based on the number of full weeks remaining in the term.

### Re-Enrollment

All students are automatically re-enrolled for the subsequent academic year once they have joined.

### Overdue Payments

Annual due dates are specified on the invoice, and overdue payments will incur a monthly surcharge of 1.25%. The school reserves the right to withhold school documents, transcripts, and take appropriate legal action in the event of overdue payments and outstanding amounts owed to the school.

### Student Group Accidental Insurance

KIS provides a Student Group Accidental Insurance Policy that applies to school-sanctioned activities supervised by school authorities throughout the year, including field trips, sports events, tournaments, and military reserve training. The policy covers accidental medical treatment, as well as loss of life, dismemberment, loss of sight, or permanent disability. While the school considers this coverage reasonable and acceptable, it is highly advisable for each student to have their own medical policy tailored to their circumstances.





### Refund Policy & Withdrawal Notice

All fees paid are non-refundable unless a term's notice has been provided. Please contact admissions to request the online Withdrawal Notice Form. For the upcoming academic year of 2024/25, withdrawal notice must be given on or before the following dates:

#### Withdrawal Term 1

22 April 2024

#### Withdrawal Term 2

8 August 2024

#### Withdrawal Term 3

6 January 2025

If you intend to withdraw for the academic year 2025/26, a withdrawal notice must be provided on or before 21 April 2025.

Upon providing one term's notice, only tuition and boarding fees for unused full terms, and the School Development Fund if applicable, will be refunded after deducting any outstanding fees.

### Force Majeure

In the event of a force majeure closure of the school or other unforeseeable adverse circumstances beyond the school's control, no fees will be refunded. Lost days will only be rescheduled if the Head of School deems it necessary to maintain educational objectives.

## 01 Apply Online

## 02 Play Session or Assessment

Children applying for Early Years will be asked to join a play session. For applications to Grade 1 and above a short assessment and interview with either our admissions team or leadership team is required. This is a chance for us to get to know your child better and ensure our school will allow them to reach their full potential.

For families currently overseas and looking for day or boarding places, our admissions team will contact you to discuss this part of the process to ensure it is as simple as possible when applying from abroad.

## 03 Offers & Acceptance

Following our play session or assessment, if we believe KIS Reignwood Park would be a great fit to allow your child to flourish then a formal offer will be made. To accept your place, parents must sign a letter of acceptance and make payment of our school's registration and development fees.

## 04 KIS Family Orientation Day

New families confirmed to join us are invited to school where they meet with their School Principal and teachers, and get to know their way around their new campus and classroom in readiness for their start at KIS Reignwood Park.

## 05 First Day at KIS Reignwood Park

On your child's first day at school, we are all on hand to ensure a smooth transition and an exciting start to your time at KIS Reignwood Park. Early in Term 1, we host information and parent evenings for each of our grades, and ad-hoc sessions for students joining during the term, giving you an update on how your child has settled and the plans and goals for the coming term.
