



# Uniform Policy

The Chesapeake Public Charter School has a school uniform policy. We believe our school uniform policy will help us foster a school environment conducive to learning. The uniform requirements for Monday - Thursday are as follows:

### COLORS

#### SOLID UNIFORM

- Tops**

- Bottoms**

### TOPS

#### SOLID UNIFORM

- Collared polos, turtlenecks, oxfords
- Sweaters, cardigans, fleece and sweatshirts with small appliques or solids only

### BOTTOMS

#### SOLID UNIFORM

- Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris or jumpers
- Polo style dress
- Leggings, shorts, or tights of any color must be worn under dresses, jumpers, and skirts
- No denim

### FOOTWEAR

- Closed-toed athletic or dress shoes
- Crocs and boots are acceptable
- No Heelys
- Athletic shoes must be worn for PE

### HEAD COVERINGS & COLD WEATHER

All cold weather jackets that are not white, navy or light blue are for outdoors only. When wearing head coverings indoors, the student's face should be visible and not interfere with instruction or safety.

### WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU DO NOT WEAR SCHOOL UNIFORM?

Student will be sent to the office/nurse. If we cannot provide clothing, parents will be called to bring appropriate clothing. The SMCPS Student Code of Conduct will be followed for repeat violations.
