



Getting Familiar with Literacy Pro

Help your child log in to Literacy Pro using a computer, tablet, or smartphone. If you don't have a login yet, reach out to your child's teacher.

	Select a word to hear the pronunciation. (Make sure your volume is turned on!)
	Note the "Think More" button. This is where your child can test their comprehension after they complete the book.
	Close the book. The next time you open this book, it will begin right where you left off!

	Click on "Filter" to see how you can refine your search even more
	□ Note that you can add any title to your child's bookshelf ("My Books") by selecting □ on the title card.
	You will see only "ebooks" by default as ebooks can be read immediately. If you can take your child to the local library or bookstore to find print books, then you can switch the toggle to "ebooks and paperbacks" to see which print books come up!
C	Look at the "Profile" tab.
	Note that your child can change their avatar and interests by selecting the pencil icon $arrho$
	Note the goals section, where you can review your child's goals and adjust them together.
	Use the reading log to review which titles your child has read already.
	Select "Add to Log." This is where your child can add reading minutes from any print title that they've read. (eBook reading
	is automatically tracked.)

You will see a place to rate and review the title. Your child can complete this section after they finish any text—digital or print!

Check in on your child's reading journey! Some suggestions:

Help your child select a new title to read,

Go to "Search" to look for ...

- specific ebook titles
- · a book based on theme, interest, or another category



Review your child's reading activity by looking at their profile and dashboard.

- Does your child want to change their avatar or update their interests?
- Is your child making progress toward their reading goals? Does your child want to change their goals?
- · Has your child completed the book?
- . If your child read a print title, did they add their reading minutes to Literacy Pro (i.e., log time)?
- · If your child finished a book, ask, "What did you like about the book? Would you recommend this book to others? Why?" Encourage your child to rate the book and write a review. (Only the teacher will see the written reviews.)

Read an ebook together.

Select an ebook to read. Open it by clicking on the book cover and then selecting

- . Use the e-tools to highlight words and jot down reactions to the text.
- · Click on a word to hear how it's pronounced.

Read a print title together.
