The Board of Education met on Monday, November 23, 2015 at The Blair Community Administration Building for a 7:00pm Special Board Meeting. Items for Discussion:

1. Facility Plan:

A. Continued review of items for consideration in the areas of Building Infrastructure, Safety, and Building Systems.

- Mr. Schjodt, Board President, asked the Board for any comments from the November 9, 2015 regular Board meeting regarding the action to not consolidate our K-2 buildings and continue with our current building use configuration. No comments were offered.
- Board discussion on the Facility Plan components continued reflecting changes requested from the Board. The Board rated each item listed on the study numerical 1-2-3 in reference to:
 1. Critical
 2. Necessary
 3. In Need of Improvement

B. Scheduling of Public Forums for input and feedback.
