

All incoming 6th grade students need to do the residency verification before walk through on August 1st. If you would like to bring your documents in person, the office is open from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. through June 28th. You can send your documents by email to Karen Gunter, Office Manager at gunterk@mdusd.org. Please put your student's name in the subject line if you are sending documents by email.

Below is a list of documents that can be used to verify your residence:

One (1) from this category –

CATEGORY 1: Parent Picture ID:

- Current California Driver's License,
- Current California ID Card,
- Valid Passport or Consulate-Issued Picture ID
- Military ID

Two (2) Documents from Category 2

CATEGORY 2:

- Current valid vehicle registration
- State or Federal Tax Return filed within the past 12 months with W-2 forms attached. (Business returns do not meet residency requirements).
- Current Voter Registration Receipt
- Other forms of identification or communication from a government agency
- Property Tax Bill with parents name and property address indicating home owner's exemption
- Rental/Lease Agreement with parent's name, student's name and address, as well as the manager or owner's name and phone number (verification required)
- Payroll stubs/checks

Utility (PG&E, water, etc.) P.O. Box, telephone/cell bills, or deeds are NOT VALID residency verification documents.

If we do not receive your residency verification by August 1st, your student will not get their class schedule at walk through.
