The Lake County Office of Education operates nine preschool classrooms and two alternative education schools that serve the expelled youth of Lake County (Hance) and students with extreme behaviors (CCS). Because of the small amount of funding received through Proposition 28, LCOE programs are not required to hire arts education staffing as outlined in the proposition requirements. All Proposition 28 funding will be devoted to art and music supplies to our classrooms and special projects involving the arts.
