### Fitzgerald High School College and Career Academy Core Content Goal(s):

- 1. Increase the number of students reading on grade level by 10% based on the Growth Measure, grade-level assessments, and GMAS.
- FHSCCA will have documented monthly communication with parents in regard to academics, extra-curricular, and co-curricular activities.
- 3. Increase the number of students performing on grade level in mathematics by 10% based on grade-level assessments, district assessments, and milestones.
- 4. Increase the number of students passing the EOPA by 10%.

## Fitzgerald High School College and Career Academy Responsibilities:

Our teachers and school administrators will work with parents to support students' success, whether through face-to-face or online learning in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Some ways we will do this are the following:

- 1. Hold parent workshops to provide parents with information and strategies to use at home to help students succeed in all four content areas: English, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- 2. Send home study guides, website information, and other study materials for parents to use to help their student/s.
- 3. Update grades weekly in Infinite Campus to provide continuous online parent access to their student's grades.
- 4. Send home progress reports every four and one-half weeks.
- 5. Send home grade report cards every nine weeks.
- 6. Have reasonable access to staff through written notes, phone calls, emails, and parent conferences as needed.
- 7. Provide students with extended learning opportunities to improve skill deficits in reading and math.
- 8. Contact parents when a student's grade is below 70.

### Parent Responsibilities:

Parent support is a key component of ensuring that students succeed at school through face-to-face instruction or online learning. As the parent of an FHSCCA student, I agree to support my child in the following ways:

- 1. Attend parent workshops offered at my child's school.
- 2. Use the strategies learned at the parent workshops to help my child at home.
- 3. Use the materials sent home by the teachers to help my child study and complete assignments.
- 4. Arrange for my child to stay for tutoring when they are struggling.
- 5. Check the Parent portal weekly to view my child's grades and/or missing work.

## Student Responsibilities:

FHSCCA students share in the responsibility for improving academic achievement. In an effort to succeed both inside and outside of the classroom, whether through face-to-face instruction or online learning, I agree to regularly:

- 1. Write down assignments daily, do homework when assigned and turn work in on time.
- 2. Pay attention, participate in class, ask questions, and be engaged in learning and mastering the state standards.
- 3. I will work on and study using the materials sent home by my teacher.
- 4. Attend tutoring offered after school when assigned by teachers or administrators.
- 5. Review my grades on the student portal at least once a week.
