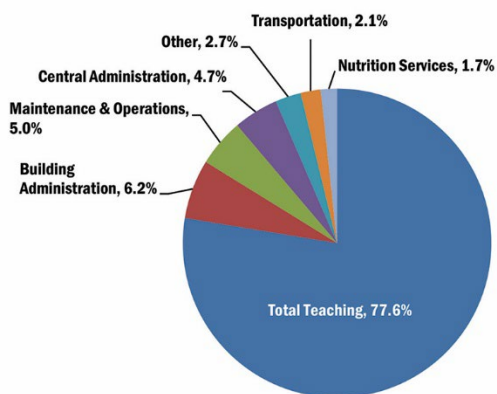

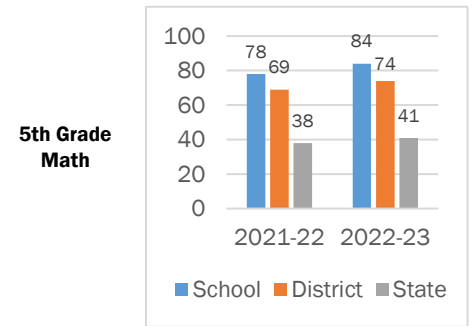
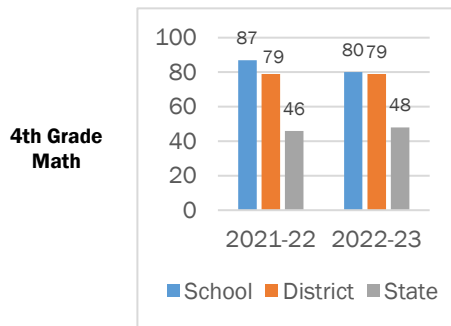
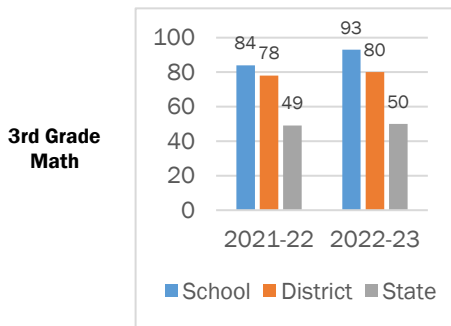
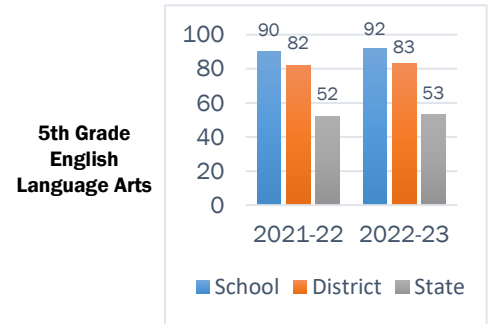
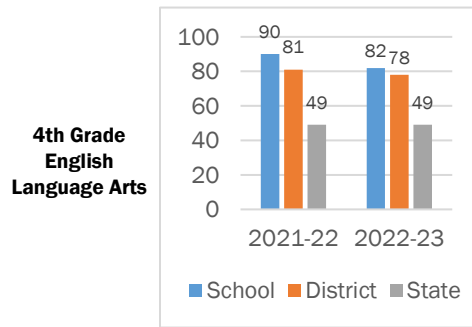
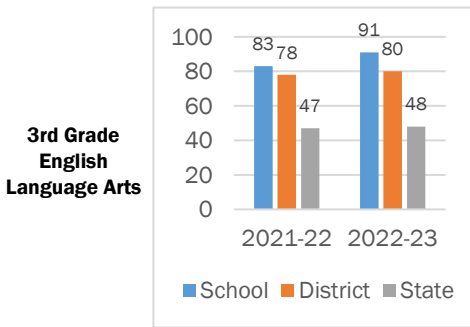
## 2022-23 School Goals

Teacher leadership met to analyze data and set goals. Grade-level teams meet monthly to assess progress.

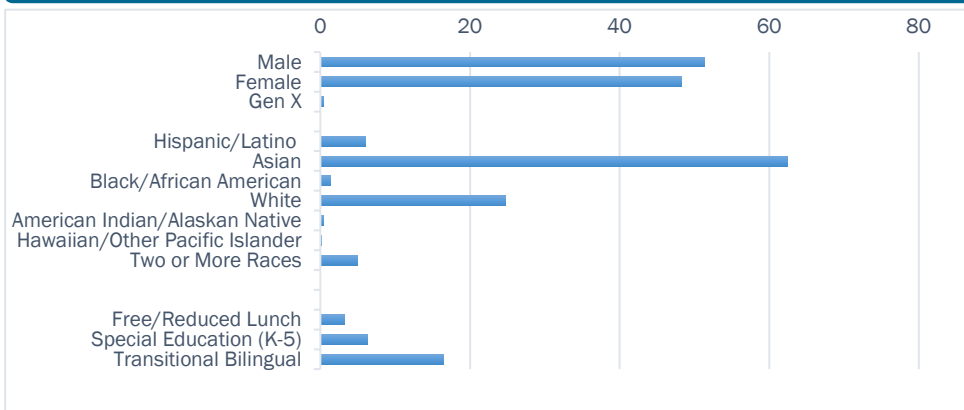
- Grades K-2 Reading: 90% of kindergarten, 92% of 1<sup>st</sup> grade and 95% of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students at benchmark on end of year FastBridge
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 93% of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 92% of 4<sup>th</sup> grade, and 89% of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score at/near grade level as measured by the Smarter Balanced ELA Assessment
- Grades 3-5 Math: 90% of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 91% of 4<sup>th</sup> grade, and 84% of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score at/near grade level as measured by the Smarter Balanced Math Assessment
- Grade 5 Science: 87% at standard
- Achievement gap: 70% of ELL students in grades 3-5 at standard
- School Effectiveness: 80% of teachers will Agree Completely or Agree Mostly that "School leadership cares about me"
- Attendance: 7% of student absences will be considered "unexcused" absences as recorded by the registrar in Skyward by the end of the 2018-2019 school year.
- Discipline: Utilizing the PUMAS school-wide positive behavior intervention structure, office referrals will decrease to fewer than 60.
