

- The Facility Advisory Committee (FAC) spent about 10 months preparing a bond recommendation for the Board
- The FAC was made up of parent and community volunteers, certificated instructional and classified staff, principals, and capital projects staff

# Considerations for combining grades 6, 7, and 8 for middle school:



- Learning standards shift between 5th and 6th grade
- Learning standards and curriculum are designed for K-5, 6-8, and 9-12
- 6th graders have more access to activities
- Wider grade spans are more beneficial for course offerings
- Access to lab science in 6th grade
- Greater sense of belonging for students in a three year middle school

# When would 6th graders move?

- The goal is to complete all middle school construction, including a 5th middle school, for the start of the 2028-29 school year
- This current school years 1st graders would be the first group of students to attend middle school as 6th graders

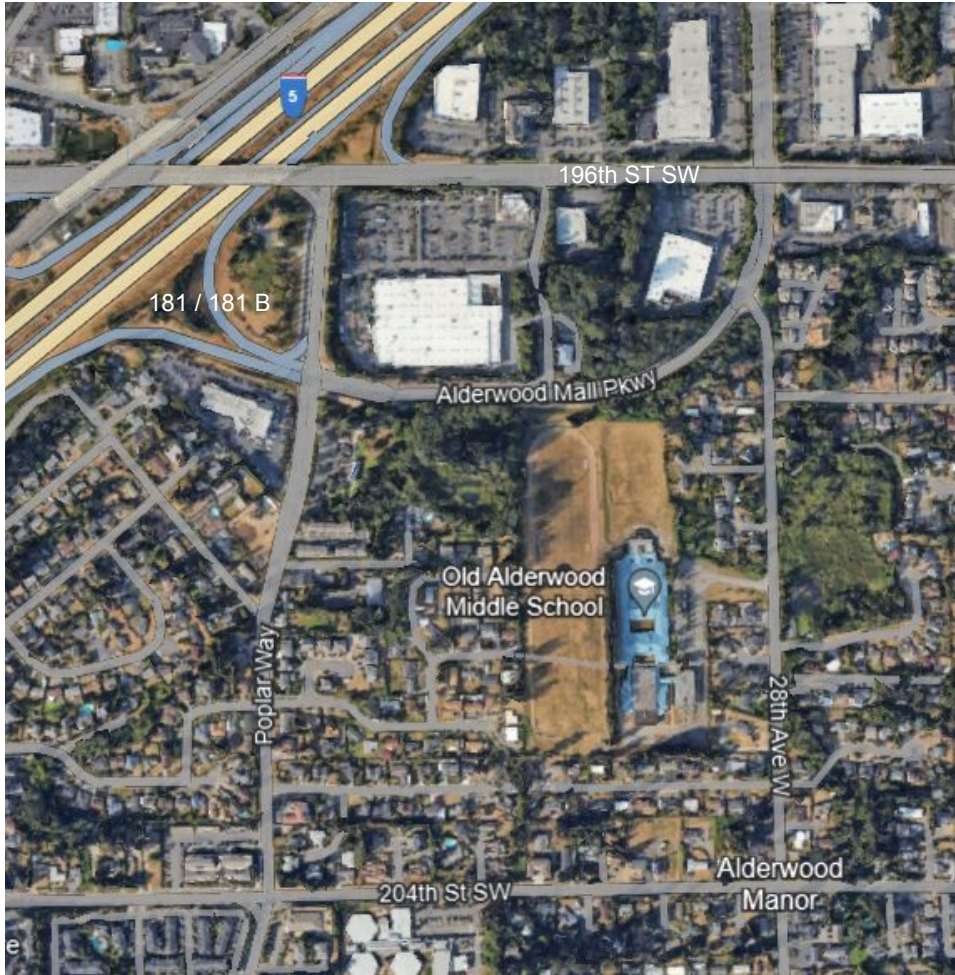


# Proposed Bond Projects

- **Bond renewal and upgrade projects**

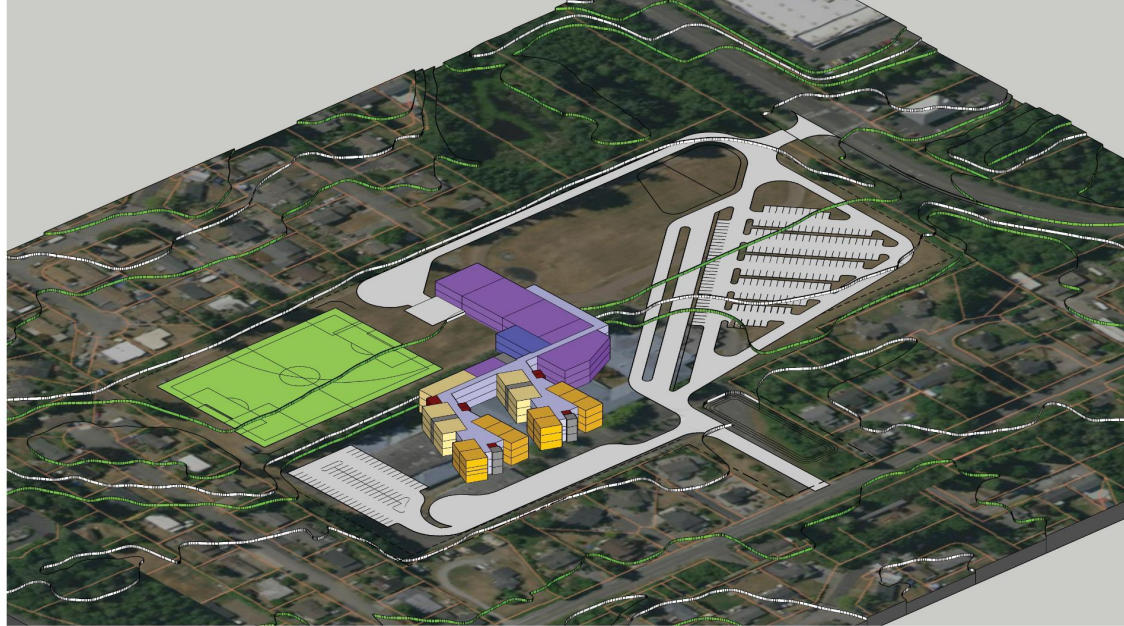
# New Middle School

(at Former Alderwood Middle School)

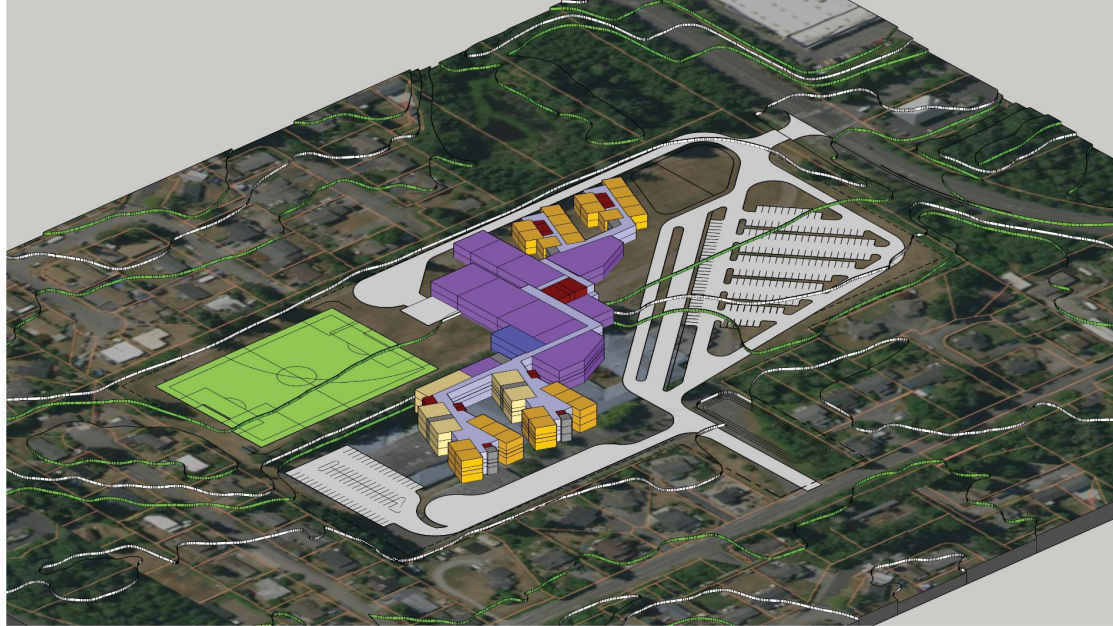


Site Location

# Possible configuration of Westgate

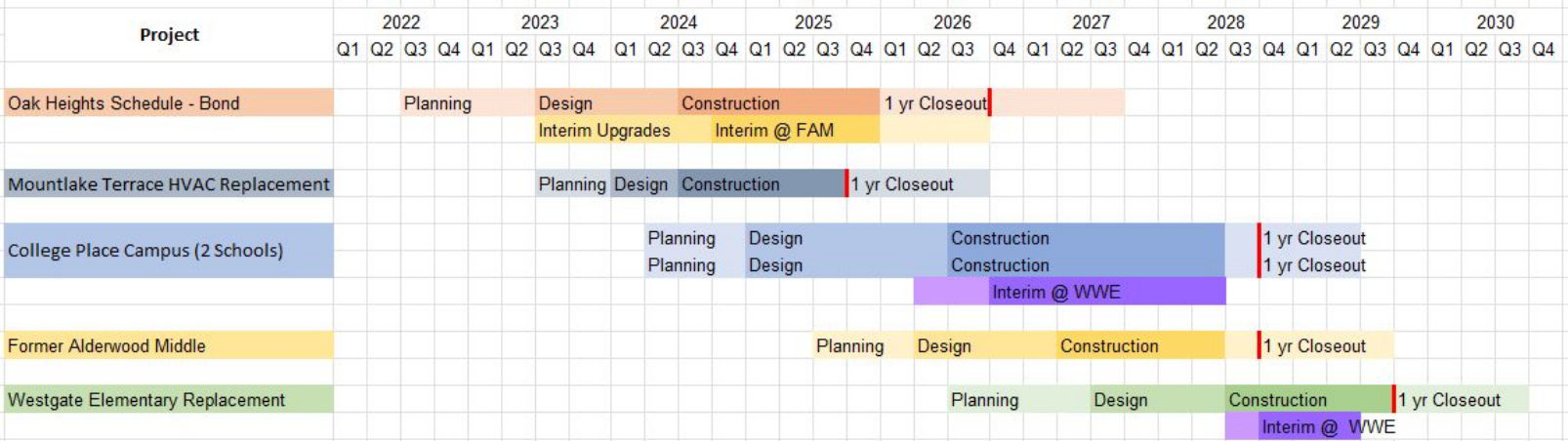


# Bond Renewal and Upgrade Projects

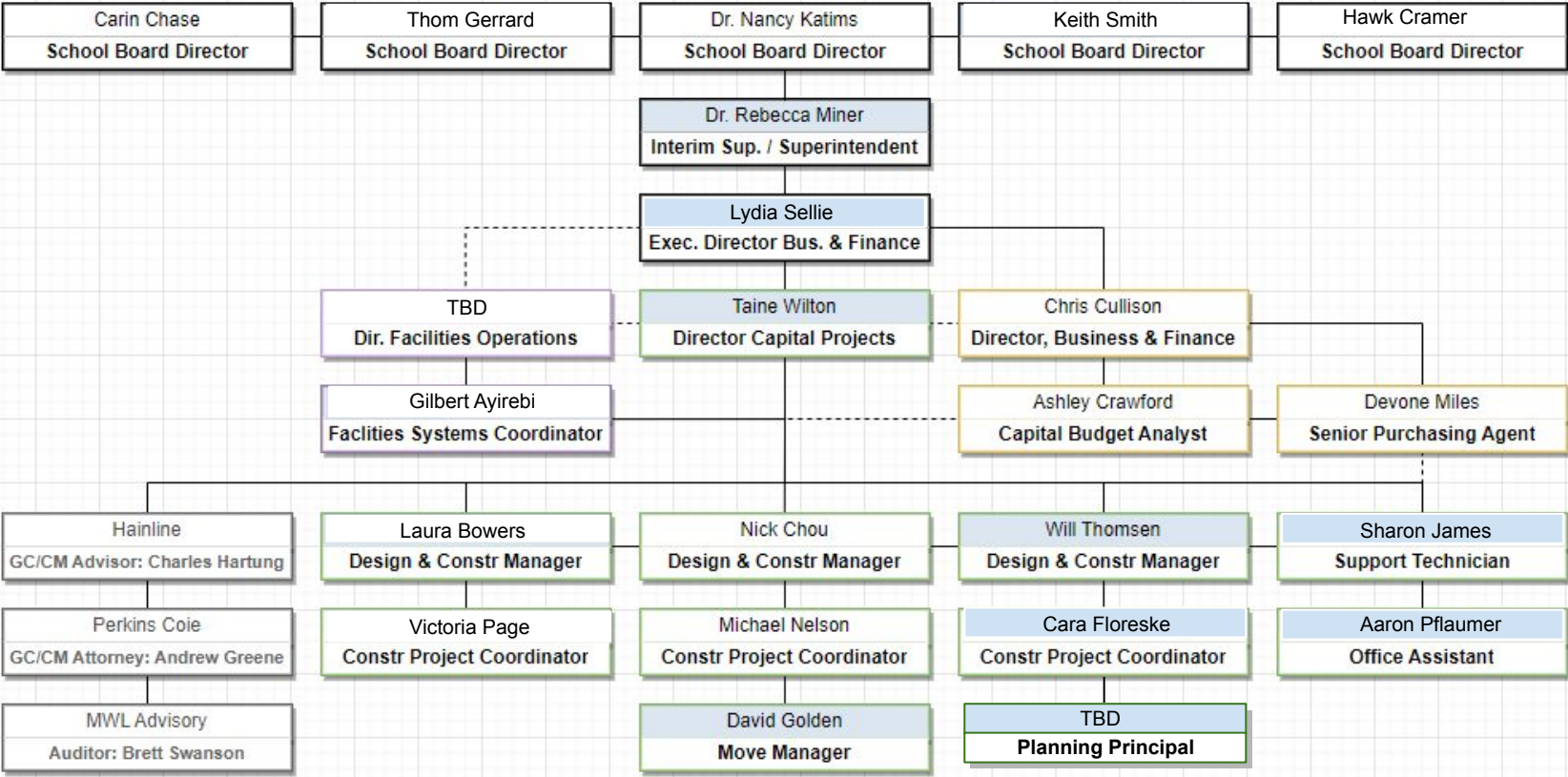
- Safety Improvements and Accessibility/Americans with Disabilities Act
- Site Upgrades, Fields, Field Turf, Tracks Replacements
- Boilers, HVAC Replacements and Upgrades \*
- Roofs and Building Envelope (e.g. windows and doors) Upgrades \*
- Lighting Upgrades and Building Technology Lifecycle \*

*\*These projects improve energy efficiency and reduce overall district resource use to meet the Washington State Energy Code and the Clean Buildings Act*
