



### **The Sixth Form Dress Code – Year 12 and Year 13**

The Sixth Form Dress Code is a privilege afforded to Year 12 and Year 13 pupils who for the first time have a choice in the attire they wear to school. The expectation is that pupils are smart yet comfortable and ready for a day of focused learning.

- Tops may include plain tshirts, polo shirts or smart tops, without large logos, writing or slogans
- Tops should cover the torso
- Shorts, skirts or dresses should be towards the knee in length
- Smart denim clothing may be worn but not with rips
- Footwear should be close-toed shoes or trainers in good condition. Flip flops are not permitted
- Accessories should be discreet
- No hoods or caps should be worn inside the school building

Students who are unsure may ask the Sixth Form Team.



### **PE Lessons in the Sixth Form**

Pupils are expected to wear suitable clothing for the activity they take part in. This includes:

- Tshirts, running vests, jumpers

- Shorts, tracksuit bottoms, leggings
- Suitable trainers for PE use only (converse are not permitted)
- Football boots for all activities on the Astroturf
- Shin pads for football and hockey

Pupils should not wear crop tops.

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
